 - If vehicle is not under the company’s name or the owner of the company, customer will need to provide Company Letterhead, authorizing this vehicle to a designated employee.
- Check made payable to SFMTA. If applying in person, we accept cash, check, Visa and MasterCard

- Check made payable to SFMTA. If applying in person, we accept cash, check, Visa and MasterCard.
*Students and businesses can have the vehicle registration and insurance at another address.

For Business Vehicles:

- Copy of Current CA DMV Registration
 - If vehicle is not under the company's name or the owner of the company, customer will need to provide Company Letterhead, authorizing this vehicle to a designated employee
 - New Vehicle without plate would have to provide purchase/lease agreement
- Check made payable to SFMTA. If applying in person, we accept cash, check, Visa and MasterCard
