3rd Street between Channel Street and Evans Avenue (Supervisor Districts 6 & 10) (Requires approval by the SFMTA Board) Alvin Lam, alvin.lam@sfmta.com

Proposal to lower the speed limit based on new speed survey findings.

Public Comments: Comment in opposition received during public hearing regarding the time of speed survey conducted.

Decision: Approved by the City Traffic Engineer to forward to the SFMTA Board for final approval and implementation.

2. RESCIND – 25 MPH SPEED LIMIT ESTABLISH – 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Proposal to prohibit northbound and westbound left turns in conjunction with traffic signal modifications to address traffic congestion.

This proposal adds 2-hour Area H RPP parking, Mon-Fri from 8 AM to 6 PM to San Leandro Way, east side, from Ocean Avenue to 260 feet northerly and was requested by residents by a signed petition.

Decision: Approved by the City Traffic Engineer to forward to the SFMTA Board for final approval and implementation.

10(a). RESCIND – PASSENGER LOADING, 5-MINUTE LIMIT, 8AM to 9:30AM and 2:30PM to 4PM, SCHOOL DAYS

Prague Street, south side, from Naylor Street to 80 feet westerly (80-foot zone)

10(b). ESTABLISH – PASSENGER LOADING, 5-MINUTE LIMIT, 8AM to 9:30AM and 2:30PM to 4PM, SCHOOL DAYS

Willow Street, south side, from 28 feet to 70 feet west of Larkin Street

11(p). RESCIND - TOW AWAY NO STOPPING ANY TIME

Willow Street, south side, from 47 feet to 70 feet west of Larkin Street

11(q). RESCIND – FARMERS MARKET PERMIT PARKING ONLY, 3AM TO 6PM, WEDNESDAY AND SUNDAY, VEHICLES WITH PERMITS EXEMPT FROM METERS ON WEDNESDAY AND SUNDAY

Larkin Street, east side, from 146 feet to 168 feet south of McAllister Street (metered space #214-G)

11(r). ESTABLISH – FARMERS MARKET PERMIT PARKING ONLY, 3AM TO 6PM, WEDNESDAY AND SUNDAY, VEHICLES WITH PERMITS EXEMPT FROM METERS ON WEDNESDAY AND SUNDAY

McAllister Street, south side, from 12 feet to 36 feet west of Larkin Street (Supervisor Districts 3, 5, & 6) (Requires approval by the SFMTA Board) Elizabeth Chen, elizabeth.chen@sfmta.com

Proposal to implement turn restrictions and traffic calming on Larkin Street, between Market Street and Sutter Street.

Public Comments: Comment in opposition received during public hearing, citing that reduced throughput on Larkin and poor signal timing create driver frustration and lead to No Turn on Red violations.

Decision: Approved by the City Traffic Engineer to forward to the SFMTA Board for final approval and implementation.

- Comment received regarding starting the public hearing late.
- Comment received regarding lowered speed limit and speed safety cameras on Geary.
- Comment received regarding dual turn removals at Eureka and Market, Fell and Franklin, and Cesar Chavez and South Van Ness.

Whether or not the City Traffic Engineer's decision is considered a Final SFMTA Decision is determined by Division II, Section 203 of the Transportation Code. If the City Traffic Engineer approves a parking or traffic modification, it is considered a Final SFMTA Decision. If the City Traffic Engineer disapproves or declines a parking or traffic modification, a member of the public must request additional review by the SFMTA of that

decision which shall be conducted pursuant to Division II, Section 203 of the Transportation Code before the decision becomes a Final SFMTA Decision. Final SFMTA Decisions, whether made by the City Traffic Engineer or the SFMTA Board, can be reviewed by the Board of Supervisors pursuant to Ordinance 127-18. Decisions reviewable by the Board of Supervisors are denoted with a pound (#).
