

Hi Forrest – Apologies as I thought I responded to this email earlier.

The parking changes on the Bryant frontage, including loading zone changes, were heard at Color Curb public hearing earlier this year and was approved. However, the parking legislation in the alley for the sidewalk widening was placed on hold earlier this summer as the neighbor filed an appeal with Board of Appeals regarding the sidewalk changes. That Board of Appeals process concluded and the next step is to move forward with Public Hearing for the alley parking changes in mid Oct and then MTAB in Dec.

Hi Forrest and Norman,

Per the staff report you shared, it appears the project received ministerial approval which is why CEQA was not required. We can use the attached memo as documentation of this.

We can say something to the effect of:

Ministerial projects are exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) per Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations Section 15268.

On June 30, 2021, the Planning Department determined (Case No. 2021-000947PRJ) that the 555-585 Bryant Street project complies with the requirements of the Central SoMa Housing Sustainability District under San Francisco Planning Code section 343, and is thereby ministerially approved.

Happy to look at the language again once it is in eRouting. We should also flag this for the assigned CAO to review.

Hi Norman,

If the project was exempt from CEQA, we would still need to reference a case number to the determination made by Planning. I am not sure what that case number would be.

My read is that it was exempt from CEQA but because it falls under a Housing Sustainability District, the project would rely on the Central SoMa EIR, so that case number should be used, but I am not sure.

Jenny – do you know what case number we should use for the Public Hearing legislation? Norman wants to legislate sidewalk improvements via the Public Hearing, and the sidewalk improvements are related to the 555 Bryant Street infill development project, so we wanted to reference the environmental case number for that project.

Berhane, Norman, Karina, Capt. Flores,

BKF surveyed Welsh Street and discovered a discrepancy in the width measured from the 555 Bryant Street property line to the back of side walk on the south side. The existing condition is only 27'-6" wide and not the assumed 28'-0". See attached sketch with the two options described below

Option 1: Maintain 14'-0" wide sidewalk and reduce the street down to 13'-6" Option 2: Maintain 14'-0" wide street and reduce the sidewalk down to 13'-6"

Please let me know if the City has a preference on the two options.


