### **Sustainable Streets Division Directive Order No. 6962**

Pursuant to the public hearing held on December 5, 2025, traffic movement and safety may be improved by the changes approved below. The Environmental Clearance for these items is noted on Order No. 6954.

#### **1. ESTABLISH – CONCRETE TRAFFIC ISLANDS**

Proposal to modify the existing traffic diverter comprised of traffic paint and plastic posts at the southeast corner of this intersection by replacing with concrete traffic islands.

**Public Comments:** Comments in support received during public hearing. Questions raised regarding the need to replace existing infrastructure with concrete islands, and SFFD review and approval.

**Decision:** Approved by the City Traffic Engineer for implementation.

Overall comments also mentioned the installation was done without proper notice.

## Directive Order No. 6962

**Decision:** Clarified establishment of tow-away restriction to accommodate sidewalk widening. Approved by the City Traffic Engineer to forward to the SFMTA Board for final approval and implementation.

### GENERAL COMMENTS:

- Comment received regarding pavement markings on speed humps, and preference for speed tables over speed humps.
- Comment received against removal of dual turn lanes.
- Comment received regarding approval of projects with parking removal and its impact to businesses.
- Question raised regarding process to submit curb zone changes.

*Whether or not the City Traffic Engineer's decision is considered a Final SFMTA Decision is determined by Division II, Section 203 of the Transportation Code. If the City Traffic Engineer approves a parking or traffic modification, it is considered a Final SFMTA Decision. If the City Traffic Engineer disapproves or declines a parking or traffic modification, a member of the public must request additional review by the SFMTA of that decision which shall be conducted pursuant to Division II, Section 203 of the Transportation Code before the decision becomes a Final SFMTA Decision. Final SFMTA Decisions, whether made by the City Traffic Engineer or the SFMTA Board, can be reviewed by the Board of Supervisors pursuant to [Ordinance 127-18](#). Decisions reviewable by the Board of Supervisors are denoted with a pound (#).
