#### **Martin Luther King Day Holiday Parking Enforcement**

**Monday, Jan. 19 (Martin Luther King Day Holiday):** **Parking meters (all meters, regardless of cap color), passenger loading (white) and general loading zones, nightly street sweeping (street cleaning) and safety violations (no stopping, no parking, red and blue zones) will be enforced citywide.**

Other SFMTA parking programs will not be enforced:

- Residential Parking Permits (RPP) Zones
- General Parking Time Limits
- Weekday Daytime Street Sweeping (Street Cleaning)
- Commuter Shuttle Towaway Zones
- Unmetered Yellow and Green Zones

### Martin Luther King Day Holiday Parking Enforcement continued

Vehicles creating a hazard and/or an unsafe condition (i.e. double parking, blocking a bike lane, blocking driveways, blocking crosswalks, fire hydrants, etc.) are subject to receiving citations and can possibly be towed.

Parking meters in the City are enforced Monday through Saturday **with the exception of the following areas where parking meters are enforced seven days per week throughout the year except Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Year's Day:**

- Parking meters in the Fisherman's Wharf area
- Along The Embarcadero Roadway
- In the Special Event Area around Oracle Park and Chase Center
- Four metered off-street parking facilities listed below:
  - 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue at Clement Street
  - 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue at Clement Street
  - Geary Boulevard at 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue
  - 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue at Geary Boulevard

**Some parking garages (notably Pierce Street Garage between Lombard and Chestnut streets) are paid parking 24/7 including all holidays.**

**Thursday, Jan. 15 to Tuesday, Jan. 20:** There will be ball games at the Chase Center:

- **Thursday, Jan. 15:** The Warriors will host a home game against the [New York Knicks](#). Game will begin at 7 p.m. Doors will open at 5:30 p.m.
- **Friday, Jan. 16:** [The Bruce-Mahoney Basketball Doubleheader](#) between Sacred Heart Cathedral Preparatory (SHC) and St. Ignatius College Preparatory boys and girls basketball teams will take place at the Chase Center. The girls varsity basketball game will tip off at 5 p.m., and the boys varsity basketball game will tip-off at 7 p.m. Doors will open at 4:15 p.m.
- **Saturday, Jan. 17:** The Warriors will host a home game against the [Charlotte Hornets](#). Game will begin at 5:30 p.m. Doors will open at 4 p.m.
- **Sunday, Jan. 18:** [The Harlem Globetrotters](#) will play at the Chase Center. Game will begin at 3 p.m. Doors will open at 2 p.m.
- **Monday, Jan. 19:** The Warriors will host a home game against the [Miami Heats](#). Game will begin at 7 p.m. Doors will open at 5:30 p.m.
- **Tuesday, Jan. 20:** The Warriors will host a home game against the [Toronto Raptors](#). Game will begin at 7 p.m. Doors will open at 5:30 p.m.

### Event at Chase Center continued

#### ***Muni will provide supplement 78X Arena Express service:***

- *Pre-event express shuttle service from 16<sup>th</sup> Street BART Station to Chase Center will start two and a half hours before each game/event and will end one hour after game/event starts.*
- *Post-event express shuttle service from Chase Center on 16<sup>th</sup> Street to 16<sup>th</sup> Street BART Station will run until the clears.*

#### ***Special Event Parking Rates***

During basketball games and other area major events with more than 10,000 expected attendees at the arena, parking meters close to the arena will charge a special event rate of \$12 per hour. These rates help reduce congestion and keep parking spots available in the neighborhoods near the arena, discouraging circling for free or cheap parking. Start times for special event rates vary based on the start time of the event. #### ***Street Closures***

**To accommodate events that will take place at the arena, the following street closures will be enforced two hours before and one hour after each event:**

- 1) 16<sup>th</sup> Street between 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and Terry Francois Boulevard
- 2) Warriors Way between 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and Terry Francois Boulevard
- 3) Northbound 3<sup>rd</sup> Street between 16<sup>th</sup> Street and Warriors Way will also be closed approximately 30 minutes before and 45 minutes after the event.

Only local access will be allowed on Northbound Illinois Street between Mariposa and 16<sup>th</sup> streets.

#### ***No Parking Zone***

To facilitate loading and pick up for Muni customers and patrons, NO PARKING will be in effect at these locations during events:

- 16<sup>th</sup> Street between 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and Terry Francois Boulevard
- Warriors Way between 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and Terry Francois Boulevard
- Between the 500 and 700 blocks of Terry Francois Boulevard (TFB)

#### ***Taxi Stands***

There is one taxi stand located on southbound Terry Francois Boulevard.

Ramp Taxis should use the loading zone on eastbound Warriors Way at Bridgeview Way.

### **CONSTRUCTION WORK AND OTHER UPDATES**

#### **Temporary Subway Closure for PG&E Maintenance Work**

**Beginning at 10:30 p.m., Sunday, Jan. 18, will continue until 2 p.m., Monday, Jan. 19, PG&E will conduct maintenance work.** A temporary subway closure is planned to occur from 10:30 p.m., Sunday, Jan. 18 until 2 p.m., Monday, Jan. 19. The subway stations from Montgomery to Van Ness will be closed during this time. Trains will resume regular service after work is complete on Monday.

**Muni's service plan during the subway closure, between 10:30 p.m., Sunday, Jan. 18 and 2 p.m., Monday, Jan. 19 will be as follows:**

- KLM Bus Shuttles will serve all Muni Metro stops between Steuart & Market streets and Castro & Market streets. Riders must transfer at Castro & Market or Church & Market. Riders should board bus shuttles at bus stops marked with "JKLMN Metro Bus Sub".
- N Train will serve between Embarcadero Station and Caltrain and between Church & Market and Ocean Beach.
- J Train will operate between Church & Duboce and Balboa Park.
- K and M trains will operate between Church Station and Balboa Park.
- L Train will operate between Church Station and SF Zoo.
- T Third train will run its regular schedule between Sunnydale and Chinatown.

#### **Transfer Points:**

- Embarcadero:
  - Eastbound to Caltrain – Board train at Embarcadero Station
  - Westbound – Board KLM bus shuttle at Steuart & Market streets
- Castro & Market:
  - Eastbound to Downtown – Board KLM bus shuttle at the curb
  - Westbound to Balboa Park or SF Zoo – Board train at Castro Station

### **UPDATE: Caltrans Work—04-4K1104 (19<sup>th</sup> Avenue)**

**Phase 1 (Concrete Parking Strip Work) was completed.** Inspection and some electrical work will be conducted over the next three weeks. Once complete, the contractor will demobilize and will return until May/June 2026 to perform paving work.

### **UPDATE: Caltrans Work—04-1Q802 US101 (Hospital Curve)**

**This construction project will be closing on and off-ramps to restripe US-101 ahead of storm drainage improvements scope of this project.**

## **UPDATE: Bridge Rehabilitation of Central (US 101) and Bayshore (I-80) Viaducts**

The Bridge Rehabilitation of the Central (US-101) and Bayshore (I-80) Viaducts is a vital project to strengthen and rehabilitate the viaducts which are 71-years old. To facilitate the project, ramp closures are scheduled throughout the project.

The following ramp closures are scheduled for the week, from Monday, Jan. 19 to Sunday, Jan. 25:

- **Westbound I-80:** Westbound at Harrison & 7<sup>th</sup> Street on ramp will be closed overnight, from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m., the next day, starting Tuesday Jan. 20 until Thursday, Jan. 22
- **Eastbound I-80:** Eastbound at 8<sup>th</sup> & Bryant streets on ramp will be closed overnight, from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m., the next day, starting Tuesday Jan. 20 until Thursday Jan. 22
- **Southbound US101 Eastbound/Southbound Connector:** Off-ramp to eastbound I-80 will be closed from 12:01 to 5 a.m., Wednesday Jan. 21
- **Westbound I-80:** At 4<sup>th</sup> & Harrison streets on ramp will be closed overnight, from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. the next day, beginning Thursday Jan. 22 until Friday Jan. 23
- **Westbound I-80:** At westbound 8<sup>th</sup> Street Off Ramp will be closed overnight, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., the next day, beginning Thursday Jan. 22 until Friday Jan. 23
