

The Bayview Community Pathway aims to improve mobility in Bayview Hunters Point by increasing access to modes of transportation like walking, biking, rolling, or taking transit.

Adopted in February of 2020, the Bayview Community Based Transportation Plan (CBTP) directly links the needs and values of the Bayview Hunters Point community to direct action and commitments by the SFMTA. The Bayview Community Pathway seeks to improve pedestrian safety and access to community destinations on, and immediately east of, Third Street.


project elements
