



Free Muni Programs



Discount ride for Adults, 19 to 64

The **Clipper START** program offers adults ages 19–64 with low income a 50% discount on single rides as well as a monthly Muni “Lifeline” pass.

How to qualify:

- Be a resident of the Bay Area.
- Be between 19 and 64 years old.
- Have a gross income level (before taxes) at or up to the amounts below:

*Income levels subject to change annually.

The 50% single ride discount applies to all Bay Area public transit agencies.

Free Muni Programs

The **Free Muni for Seniors** program offers seniors (ages 65 and up) living in San Francisco with low-to-moderate income free access to Muni (including cable cars) when using a Senior Clipper card.

How to qualify:

- Have a Senior Clipper Card.*
- Be a resident of San Francisco.
- Meet the program Income Requirements.**

* If you have a registered Senior Clipper card, enter your card’s serial number during the application process. If you do not have a registered Senior Clipper card, you must provide proof of age during the application process.

The **Free Muni for People with Disabilities** program offers people with disabilities living in San Francisco with low-to-moderate income free access to Muni (including cable cars) when using valid Clipper Access (formerly RTC) card.

How to qualify:

- Have a Clipper Access (formerly RTC) Card.
- Be a resident of San Francisco.
- Meet the program Income Requirements.**

Other Free & Discount Fare Programs



- **50% off for Seniors** when using a Senior Clipper Card.
- **50% off for People with Disabilities** when using a Clipper Access Card.
- **Free Muni for Youth** ages 18 and under. (Youth discounts are also available on other non-Muni Bay Area transit systems when using a Youth Clipper Card.)
- **Free Muni for people experiencing homelessness** when using Muni’s Access Pass.

Some programs require a Clipper Card. Eligibility requirements and details may vary.
