Extending the T Third

- <u>Phase 1</u> of the 6.8-mile T Third line began revenue service along the Third Street corridor in April 2007, restoring light rail after 50 years.
- <u>Phase 2</u> adds 1.7 miles to San Francisco's first north-south subway with service to SoMa, Downtown, Union Square and Chinatown.









Central Subway Overview

Benefits

- Connecting dense housing, job centers, hospitals and growing neighborhoods
- Becoming busiest Muni rail line
- Reducing crowding on the 8, 30, 45
- Quick BART, CalTrain & Muni transfers

4 New Stations

- Chinatown
- Union Square/Market
- Yerba Buena/Moscone
- 4th & Brannan (surface)

Timeline

- Conceptual Design (2003–2009)
- Final Design (2010–2012)
- Construction (2010 Summer 2020)
- Revenue Service (Summer 2021)

Contract Modification 123

Approval From SFMTA Board:

- The project is beyond the monetary threshold that allows the Director of Transportation approve the contract modification
- Seeking approval of this modification and funding increase

Work is Ongoing Today:

- As a sign of good faith, Tutor Perini Corporation (TPC) already started the work
- Construction of Plaza Walls began in September 2019 and continues today
- The two elevators that serve the plaza are being fabricated and scheduled to be delivered early February 2020

- Original Budget \$6,980,000.00
- Expended Budget \$837,876.73
- Current Budget \$6,142,123.27
- Total Contract Modification Amount \$9,360,183.48
- Additional Budget Needed \$3,218,060.21
