ESTABLISH – STOP SIGN

Hearst Avenue, westbound, at Ridgewood Avenue, stopping the stem of this "T" intersection

ESTABLISH - RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING, AREA R, 2-HOUR PARKING, 9 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY, EXCEPT VEHICLES WITH AREA R PERMITS

Ivy Street, both sides, between Octavia and Laguna Streets (400 block, RPP signs on north side only; no parking on south side)

ESTABLISH - RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ELIGIBILITY, AREA V

1100 Ocean Avenue (eligibility only, no signage)

ESTABLISH - RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ELIGIBILITY, AREA L

3800 block of Geary Boulevard, south side, between 2nd Avenue and 3rd Avenue (eligibility only, no signage)

Unit block of Banneker Way, between Fulton Street and Grove Street (eligibility only, no signage)
