Pursuant to SFMTA Order No. 5444 adopted July 17, 2015, the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency will hold a public hearing to solicit public input on the following proposed changes. The hearing will be held as follows:

ESTABLISH - BUS ZONE

Lower Great Highway, from 20 feet to 120 feet north of Rivera Street (shifts existing zone 20 feet northerly, removes one parking space)

RESCIND - BUS ZONE

Parnassus Avenue, south side, from 252 feet to 345 feet east of 3rd Avenue (Establishes 3 general parking meters and 3 motorcycle parking meters)

ESTABLISH – BUS ZONE

Parnassus Avenue, south side, from 377 feet to 451 feet east of 3rd Avenue (Relocates blue zone, Meters #415, 413, and MC Meters #411, 409, and 407)

ESTABLISH – BLUE ZONE

Parnassus Avenue, north side, from 519 feet to 539 feet east of 3rd Avenue (Removes yellow Meter #410)

ESTABLISH - NO PARKING ANYTIME EXCEPT BICYCLES

Folsom Street, north side, from 18 feet to 35 feet east of 12th Street (17-foot space removes unmarked and unmetered car parking space)

ESTABLISH – RED ZONE

- A. Battery Street, east side, from Broadway to 30 feet northerly (removing one general metered space #802)
- B. Battery Street, west side, from Broadway to 30 feet northerly (removing one green metered space #801G)

RESCIND – 2-HOUR PARKING, 8 AM TO 9 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, EXCEPT VEHICLES WITH AREA S PERMITS ESTABLISH – 4-HOUR PARKING, 8 AM TO 9 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, EXCEPT VEHICLES WITH AREA S PERMITS

Divisadero Street, west side, between Page and Haight Streets (200 block)

Market Street, south side, from 164 feet to 264 feet east of 8th Street (replaces a 100 foot 6-wheel commercial loading zone)
