Washington Street, north side, from 20 feet to 35 feet east of Presidio Avenue

## ESTABLISH – 40 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT

## ESTABLISH – RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA L, 2-HOUR PARKING, 8 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, EXCEPT VEHICLES WITH AREA L PERMIT

4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, both sides, between Anza Street and Balboa Street (500 block)

## ESTABLISH – RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA L, 2-HOUR PARKING, 8 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, EXCEPT VEHICLES WITH AREA L PERMITS

6<sup>th</sup> Avenue, both sides, between Cabrillo Street and Fulton Street (700 block)

## ESTABLISH – RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA Z ELIGIBILITY

3814 and 3820 24<sup>th</sup> Street

## ESTABLISH - NO TURN ON RED

Market Street, eastbound, at 10<sup>th</sup> Street

## ESTABLISH – MEDIAN ISLANDS

Division Street, both sides, between Bryant Street and Potrero Street (constructs median barrier for bikeway in place of existing plastic delineators) \*

Items denoted with an asterisk (\*) can be approved by the City Traffic Engineer after the public hearing and such approval constitutes the CEQA **Approval Action** under S.F. Administrative Code Section 31.04(h). Otherwise, the SFMTA Board will make the final approval at a later date based on the outcome at the public hearing.

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Appeal Rights under Chapter 31 of the San Francisco Administrative Code: For Approval Actions, the Planning Department has issued a CEQA exemption determination or negative declaration, which viewed online may be at http://www.sfplanning.org/index.aspx?page=3447 . Following approval of the item by the SFMTA City Traffic Engineer, the CEQA determination is subject to appeal within the time frame specified in S.F. Administrative Code Section 31.16, typically within 30 calendar days of the Approval Action. Under CEQA, in a later court challenge, a litigant may be limited to raising only those issues previously raised at a hearing on the project or in written correspondence delivered to the Board of Supervisors or other City board, commission or department at, or prior to, such hearing, or as part of the appeal hearing process on the CEQA decision

Apparel Way, both sides, between Barneveld Avenue and Barneveld Avenue (Loop Street)

- B. 7th Street, east side, from King Street to 365 feet southerly (removes 18 parking spaces)
- C. 7<sup>th</sup> Street, east side, from 16<sup>th</sup> Street to 978 feet northerly (removes 49 parking spaces)

Sacramento Street, westbound, between Drumm Street and Front Street (legislates existing condition)

## <u>RESCIND – ABILITY OF PERMITTED COMMUTER SHUTTLE BUS TO USE MUNI BUS</u> <u>ZONE</u>

Howard Street, north side, from Fremont Street to 67 feet easterly \*

## ESTABLISH – TOW AWAY NO PARKING, PERMITTED COMMUTER SHUTTLE BUS ZONE, 6 AM to 8 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

Mission Street, south side, from 55 to 200 feet east of Spear Street (restricts parking at seven metered spaces, #33, #35, #37, #39, #41, #43, and #45)

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## ESTABLISH - PART TIME BUS ZONE, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, 7:00AM TO 7:00PM

San Jose Avenue, west side, from 80 feet to 220 feet south of Geneva Avenue (extends existing zone by 140 feet, removes 7 general parking spaces)

- A. Vicente Street, eastbound and westbound, from Lower Great Highway to 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Class II Bikeway)
- B. Vicente Street, eastbound, from 24th Avenue to 22nd Avenue (Class II Bikeway)
- C. Vicente Street, eastbound and westbound, from 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to 20<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Class II Bikeway)
- D. Vicente Street, eastbound, from 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Class II Bikeway)

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#### ESTABLISH – NO PARKING EXCEPT BICYCLES ESTABLISH – BIKE SHARE STATION

Bryant Street, west side, from 18.5 feet to 74 feet north of 22<sup>nd</sup> Street property line (52.5 feet bike share station in approximately four unmetered parking spaces, and 3-foot additional red zone buffer) \*

#### ESTABLISH – NO PARKING EXCEPT BICYCLES ESTABLISH – BIKE SHARE STATION

Grove Street, north side, from 102 feet to 180 feet east of Larkin Street (81-foot bike share station in four metered parking spaces #26, 28, 30, and 32 and 3-foot additional red zone buffer) \*
