Reduce delays and improve reliability by meeting stop spacing standards



Provide a safe space to get on and off the train



Provide an accessible ramp and platform for customers with wheelchairs

New Boarding Islands

at 42nd Ave and Taraval Islands provide a safe place for customers to get on and off the train. • An island with a ramp would allow wheelchair access to the stop.

• Would remove 26 parking spaces in Option 1 or 22 spaces in Option 2

Right Turn Only

from 42nd Ave onto Taraval Creating boarding islands through the intersection would calm traffic and reduce delays to Muni.



Remove Stop Signs

on eastbound and westbound Taraval St at 42nd Ave

- from the route.

New Transit Lanes

on Taraval St from 15th Ave to 46th Ave in both directions

- traffic.
- improves reliability.

42nd Ave and Taraval St

Design Options

 Removing a stop sign at this intersection saves time by eliminating an extra stop

• Other traffic calming and safety

measures would be added to slow down speeding cars without affecting Muni.

 A transit only lane gives Muni vehicles their own lane separate from regular

 This helps Muni bypass traffic congestion, which saves time and
