 RESCIND -- NO PARKING ANYTIME EXCEPT MOTORCYCLES
 Scott Street, east side, from Grove Street northern crosswalk to 10 feet southerly.
 ESTABLISH -- RED ZONE
 Scott Street, east side, from Grove Street southern crosswalk to 2 feet 6 inches northerly.
 Scott Street, east side, from 28 feet north of Grove Street southern crosswalk to Grove Street northern crosswalk (creating 10 foot zone).
 ESTABLISH -- NO PARKING ANYTIME EXCEPT MOTORCYCLES
 Scott Street, east side, from 2 feet 6 inches feet to 13 feet north of Grove Street southern crosswalk (creating 10 foot 6 inch zone for three motorcycle parking spaces).
 ESTABLISH -- NO PARKING ANYTIME EXCEPT BICYCLES
 Scott Street, east side, from 13 feet to 28 feet north of Grove Street southern crosswalk (creating 15 foot bicycle corral).

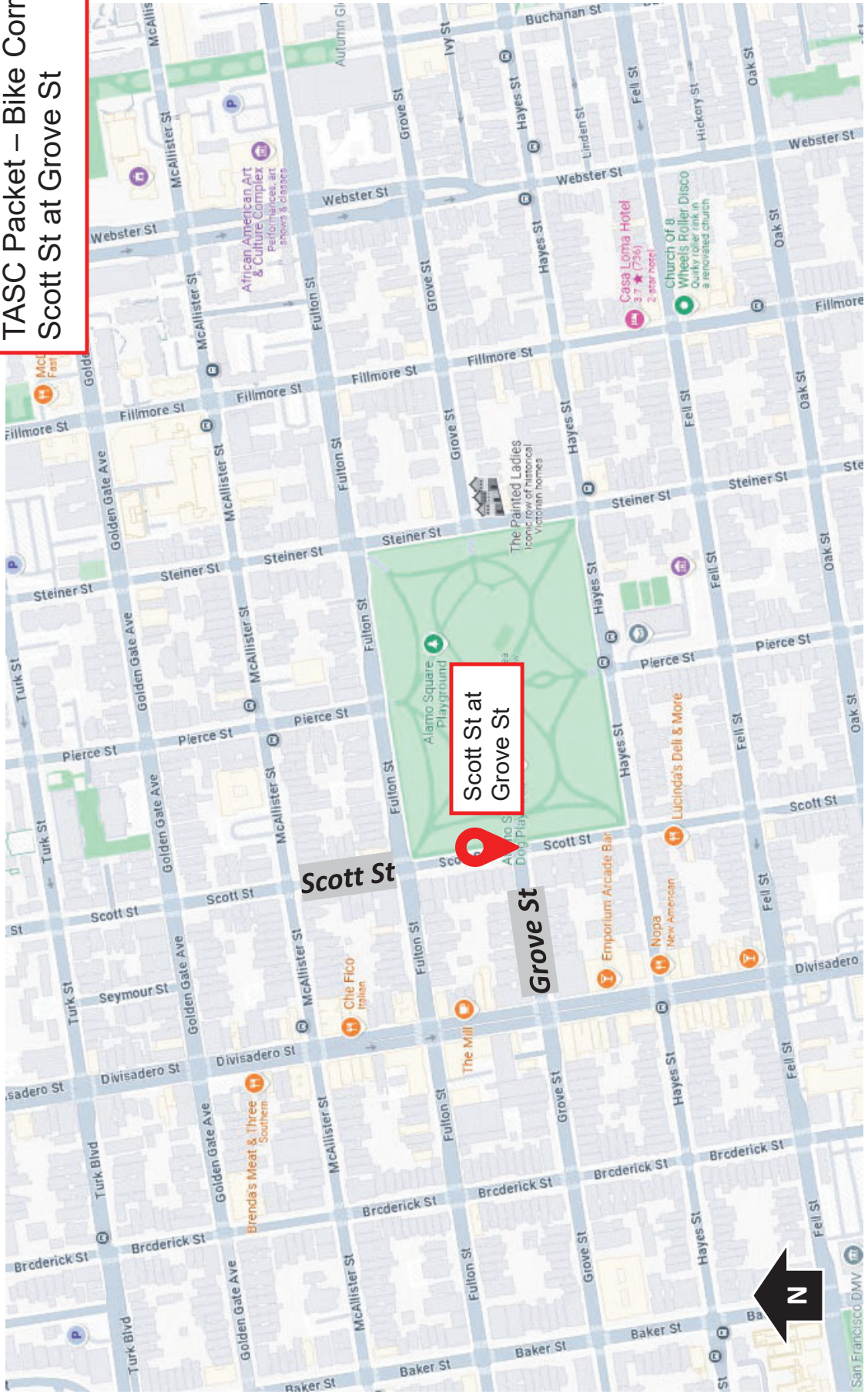
 This proposal would rearrange existing motorcycle parking and establish an on-street bicycle corral at the intersection of Scott Street and Grove Street.

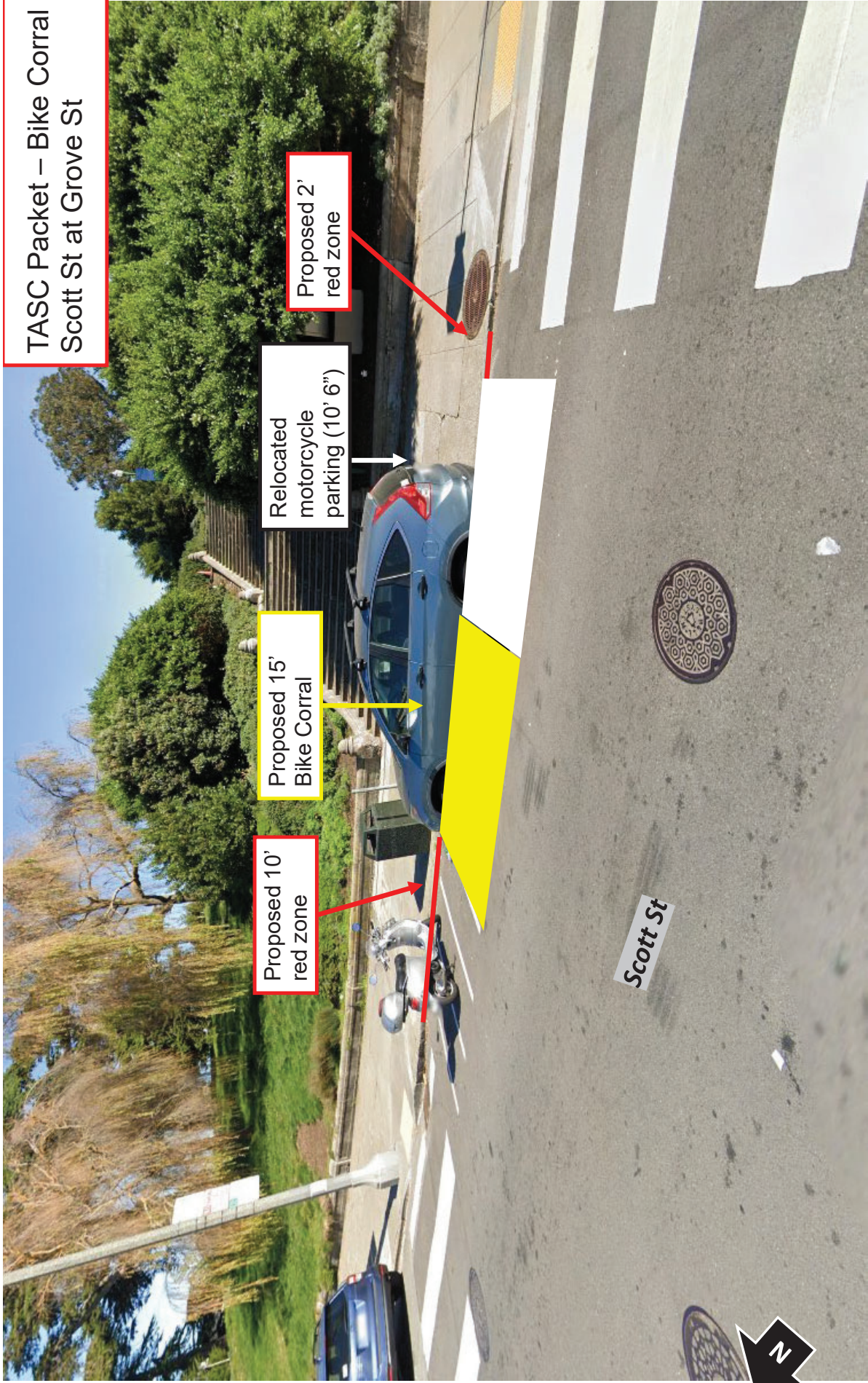

Proposed 10' red zone

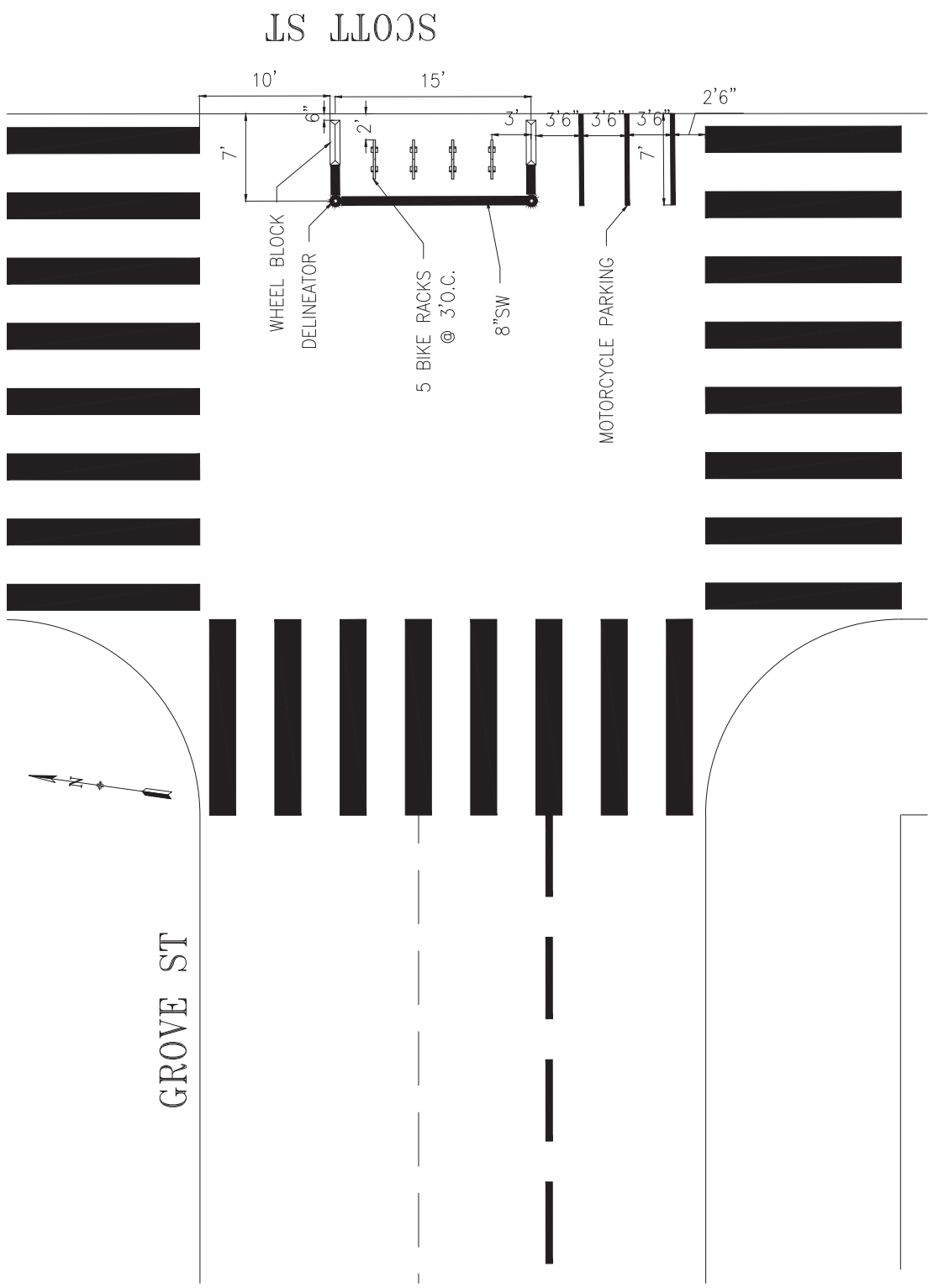
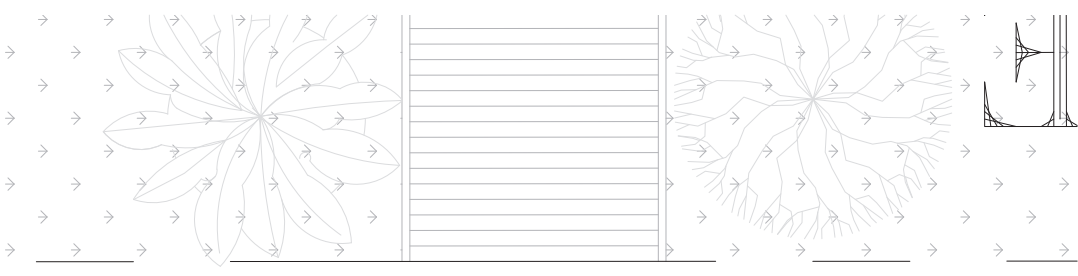
