The SFMTA, under authority delegated by the Planning Department, determined that the proposed traffic and parking modifications in Items A-I and Items O-R are categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations Section 15301 which provides an exemption from environmental review for operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities. The proposed action is the Approval Action for Items A-I and Items O-R as defined by S. F. Administrative Code Chapter 31.

On October 22, 2015, the San Francisco Planning Department determined (Case Number 2015-007975ENV) that the traffic and parking modifications in Items J-N are categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations Section 15301 which provides an exemption from environmental review for operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities, as well as Section 15308 which provides an exemption from environmental review for actions taken by regulatory agencies for protection of the environment.

WHEREAS, The public has been notified about the proposed modifications and has been given the opportunity to comment on those modifications through the public hearing process; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors, upon recommendation of the Director of Transportation and the Director of the Sustainable Streets Division approves the changes;
