RESOLUTION No. 13-203

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency has received a request, or identified a need for traffic modifications as follows:

- A. ESTABLISH – RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA N, 2-HOUR PARKING, 9 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY – 12th Avenue, both sides, between Balboa and Cabrillo Streets; Balboa Street, both sides, between 12th Avenue and Funston Street; and Cabrillo Street, both sides, between 12th Avenue and Funston Street.
- B. ESTABLISH – STOP SIGN – Munich Street, at Excelsior Avenue, stopping the stem of this "T" intersection.
- C. ESTABLISH – RED ZONE – Evelyn Way, east side, from Juanita Way to 35 feet southerly.
- D. REVOKE – LEFT LANE MUST TURN LEFT – Folsom Street, northbound, approaching 19th Street.
- E. ESTABLISH – STOP SIGNS – 45th Avenue, at Ortega Street, making this intersection an all-way STOP.

WHEREAS, These items are categorically exempt from Environmental Review Class 1(c)(9) changes in traffic and parking regulations where such changes do not establish a higher speed limit and/or result in more than a negligible increase in the use of the street and/or Class 1(c)(13) installation, modification and replacement of traffic signals, where no more than a negligible increase in the use of the street will result; and,

WHEREAS, The public has been notified about the proposed modifications and has been given the opportunity to comment on those modifications through the public hearing process; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors, upon recommendation of the Director of Transportation and the Director of the Sustainable Streets Division approves the changes; and, be it
