RESOLUTION No. 14-097

WHEREAS, Under Section 8A.104 of the Charter, the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) Board of Directors succeeded to the powers of the Board of Supervisors with respect to collective bargaining for employees in service critical classifications; and,

WHEREAS, The current Collective Bargaining Agreement between SFMTA and Service Employees International Union (SEIU), Local 1021, expires on June 30, 2014; and,

WHEREAS, After the parties reached agreement on most issues but reached impasse on others, the arbitrator entered an award on behalf of both parties that incorporated the parties tentative agreements and provides SEIU Local 1021-represented members with fair health benefits and wage increases, enhanced fringe benefits, and improved working conditions; and,

WHEREAS, The amendments to the Collective Bargaining Agreement were ratified by the membership of SEIU Local 1021 on May 28, 2014; and,

WHEREAS, The proposed amendments make 32 changes to the existing Collective Bargaining Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, The proposed amendments of the Collective Bargaining Agreement, which shall be effective July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2017, and all other required information were publicly disclosed in accordance with Charter Section 8A.104(p) on June 3, 2014, and are on file with the Secretary of the SFMTA Board of Directors; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the SFMTA Board of Directors hereby approves the amendments to the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the SFMTA and SEIU Local 1021, including extension of the term to June 30, 2017.
