





FOR PROPOSED PARKING & TRAFFIC CHANGES

Pursuant to SFMTA Order No. 5672 adopted November 4, 2016, the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency will hold a public hearing to solicit public input on the following proposed changes. The hearing will be held as follows:

Date/Time:Friday, November 18, at 10:00 amLocation:Room 416 (Hearing Room 4), City Hall, San Francisco
(located on Van Ness Avenue between McAllister and Grove Streets)

<u>ESTABLISH – RED ZONE</u>

Irving Street, north side, from 40th Avenue to 21 feet easterly

<u>RESCIND – TOW-AWAY NO PARKING, PERMITTED COMMUTER SHUTTLE BUS ZONE,</u> <u>6 AM TO 10 AM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY</u>

San Jose Avenue, west side, from Dolores Street to 45 feet northerly (Restricts parking at two unregulated parking spaces during peak AM hours)

<u>ESTABLISH – BUS ZONE</u>

Clay Street, south side, from 44 feet to 86 feet easterly (extends bus zone by 42 feet and removes 2 yellow 6-wheel commercial metered loading zones #119, 121)

<u>ESTABLISH – SIX-WHEEL YELLOW METERED LOADING ZONES, 7 AM TO 6 PM,</u> <u>MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY</u>

Clay Street, north side, from 8 feet to 58 feet east of Davis Street (establishes two metered spaces and relocates one car share space) *

ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING EXCEPT PERMITTED CAR SHARE VEHICLES

Clay Street, north side, from 58 feet to 78 feet east of Davis Street (at metered parking space #120)

REVOKE – PASSENGER LOADING ZONE AT ALL TIMES

Jones Street, east side, from 3 feet to 75 feet south of Beach Street (72-foot zone)*

<u>ESTABLISH – RED ZONE</u>

Jones Street, east side, from Beach Street to 20 feet southerly (20-foot zone)*

ESTABLISH – PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, AT ALL TIMES

Jones Street, east side, from 20 feet to 92 feet south of Beach Street (72-foot zone)*

ESTABLISH - BUS ONLY METERED PARKING, 7AM-7PM, DAILY

Jones Street, east side, from 92 feet to 157 feet south of Beach Street (65-foot zone)*

Items denoted with an asterisk (*) can be approved by the City Traffic Engineer after the public hearing and such approval constitutes the CEQA **Approval Action** under S.F. Administrative Code Section 31.04(h). Otherwise, the SFMTA Board will make the final approval at a later date based on the outcome at the public hearing.

Grant Avenue, west side, from Columbus Avenue to 46 feet northerly

ESTABLISH - RED ZONE

Sansome Street, east side, from Bush Street to 30 feet southerly (removes 8 motorcycle parking spaces)

RESCIND – BUS ZONE

ESTABLISH – METERED MOTORCYCLE PARKING

Sansome Street, east side, from 100 feet to 120 feet north of Sutter Street (shortens existing bus zone by 20 feet and establishes 6 parking spaces)

ESTABLISH - TOW-AWAY, NO STOPPING ANYTIME

Sansome Street, west side, between Washington Street and Merchants Street (extends current red zone to the south by 66 feet and removes 3 commercial metered spaces, Meter #523, #521, #519)

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ESTABLISH – NO PARKING ANYTIME

- A. Lincoln Way, north side, from the west property line of 11th Avenue to 55 feet easterly (extends existing red zone by 20-feet, removes 1 parking space)
- B. Lincoln Way, north side, from the west property line of 15th Avenue to 55 feet easterly (extends existing red zone by 20-feet, removes 1 parking space)
- C. Lincoln Way, north side, from the west property line of 17th Avenue to 65 feet easterly (extends existing red zone by 40-feet, removes 2 parking spaces)

Dolores Street Median Parking Pilot

The SFMTA is proposing a 16-month pilot that will allow drivers to park their vehicles in the travel lanes adjacent to the center medians along Dolores Street between 14th Street and 18th Street for limited periods of time on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays.

If the pilot is approved, the SFMTA will install signage on the medians displaying the times and dates during which parking in the travel lane adjacent to the Dolores Street center medians will be permitted. These proposed periods of authorized parking are as follows:

- Fridays, 7 PM 10 PM, southbound only between 15th Street and 16th Street
- Saturdays, 9AM 12PM, southbound only between 15th Street and 16th Street
- Sundays, 8AM 6PM, northbound and ٠ southbound between 14th Street and 18th Street

In addition, the pilot will use increased enforcement to prohibit:

- Parking in the spaces between medians •
- Parking in intersections •
- Parking vehicles outside of permitted hours

The diagram to the right identifies the Dolores Street medians that will be affected by the pilot.
