# Coming soon in 2016!

- In coordination with Public Works street repaving, new **bike lanes** will be installed on Bryant from Division to 17th to improve access by bike to retail, office, and open space destinations along the corridor. Bike lanes will make riding on the roadway more comfortable and safe for people biking.
- In coordination with Muni, **bus stop optimization** will help improve travel time for transit riders on the 27-Bryant route. Several bus stops may be consolidated and/or relocated.
- Pedestrian safety improvements such as **red visibility curbs** and **high-visibility crosswalks** will also be implemented along this corridor.
