SIDELETTER AGREEMENT TO THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2016 through JUNE 30, 2019 **BETWEEN THE SAN FRANCISCO MUNCIPAL TRANSPORTATION AGENCY** AND TRANSPORT WORKERS UNION, LOCAL 200

AGREEMENT ON SHIFT BID SENIORITY FOR 9153 TRANSPORTATON CONTROLLERS

In order to maintain the highly complex operational workflows in the newly-online Transit Management Center (TMC) and to retain the customary work & shift bid seniority, the Transport Worker's Union, Local 200 ("TWU Local 200") and the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) hereby agree to amend the MOU as follows:

II.H. SENIORITY

149. Seniority, for the purpose of this Article, is defined as the length of continuous service determined from the day of certification to a permanent position in a classification as described in Article I.A., except as provided for in paragraph 149.A., below,

149.A. For purposes of this Article, seniority in the 9153 Transportation Controller classification for employees who transferred from the 9150 Train Controller classification is determined by the start work date in the 9150 Train Controller classification (i.e. the first date they reported to work as a 9150 Train Controller).

149.B. Seniority for employees hired directly into 9153 Transportation Controller classification shall be calculated in accordance with Paragraph 149.

Fiscal Impact: There are no known fiscal impacts resulting from this Agreement
