

STROLLER GUIDELINE – SFMTA POLICY

Collapsible or foldable strollers are allowed on all Muni vehicles.

On Cable Cars:

- All strollers must be collapsed, and the child removed from the stroller prior to boarding

On all other vehicles:

- Strollers do not need to be collapsed. They can remain open, and passengers may request the lift/ramp to assist them in boarding with a stroller.
- While onboard, un-collapsed or open strollers must:
 - Be under their owner's control at all times
 - Have the wheel brake set
 - Cannot block the aisle or interfere with the movement of passengers
 - Cannot block or ride in the securement area
- If the vehicle is full or the stroller is interfering with passengers, you may ask the passenger to collapse the stroller.

Treat passengers with strollers riding our vehicles with professionalism and courtesy and encourage parents riding with their child in a stroller to fasten the child's seat belt.
