About the Survey

- In March 2019, the SFMTA mailed 8,962 surveys to households in the Excelsior and Mission Terrace -Cayuga neighborhoods (District 11).
- The survey closed April 1, 2019.
- The survey was available in four languages: English, Spanish, Chinese and Filipino.
- 1,879 households completed the survey—for a response rate of 21%.
- Of these, 150 or 8% were completed in a language other than English.
