Gough Street to Scott Street	Reduction from 4 mixed travel lanes in each direction to 2 travel lanes and a transit-only lane in each direction, and narrowing of traffic lanes to encourage slower vehicle speeds (in combination with other safety treatments that also encourage slower speeds)	
Collins Street to Stanyan Street	Reduction from 3 mixed travel lanes in each direction to 2 travel lanes and a transit-only lane in each direction

Buchanan Street (Peace Plaza)	New signalized crossing with median refuge and north- and south- side bulb-outs	
Webster Street	New surface crossings on east and west sides of the intersections, with three refuge areas each. Existing pedestrian overcrossing will be retained.	
Steiner Street	New surface crossing on the east side of the intersection with three refuge areas (existing surface crossing on the west side of the intersection would be upgraded with three refuge areas). Existing pedestrian overcrossing has been removed.

Geary/Commonwealth and Beaumont	New traffic signal and turn restrictions to provide dedicated pedestrian crossing phase without turn conflicts
