## **Temporary Emergency Transit Lanes**

- Keep buses moving and reduce crowding
- Complete trips in less time, return to service more quickly
- Provide more frequent service with same number of buses
- Automatically removed within 120 days after emergency order is lifted, unless there is a public process to make a lane permanent
- Will not be painted red





## **Program Benefits**

- Equity: Transit lanes <u>reduce the risk</u> of exposure for people who have <u>the fewest travel choices</u> and ensure there is enough capacity on board, especially for lower-income people of color
- Public Health: Reducing crowding on transit is imperative to preventing the spread of COVID-19
- Economic Recovery: A strong economic recovery is dependent on an efficient transit system
