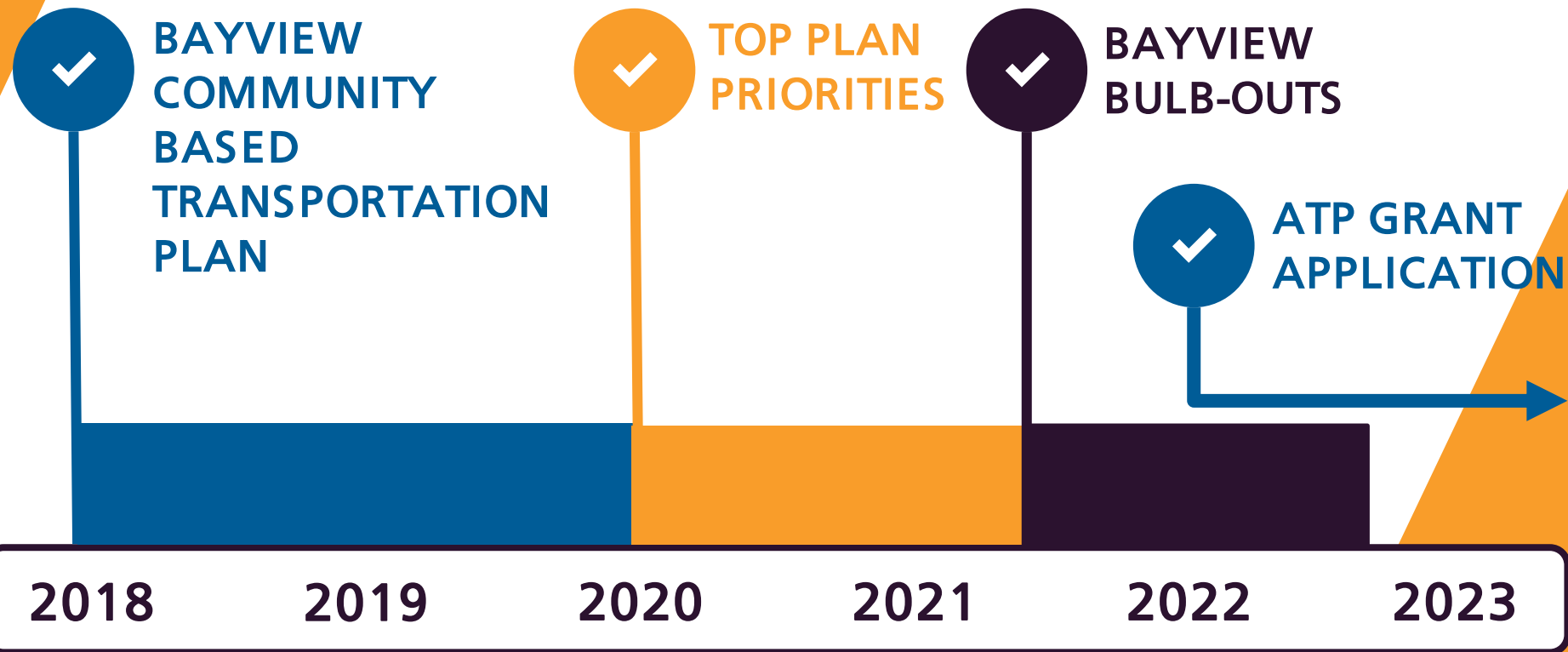

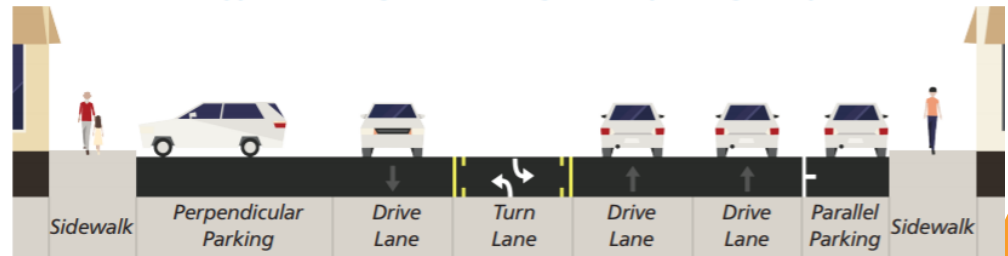

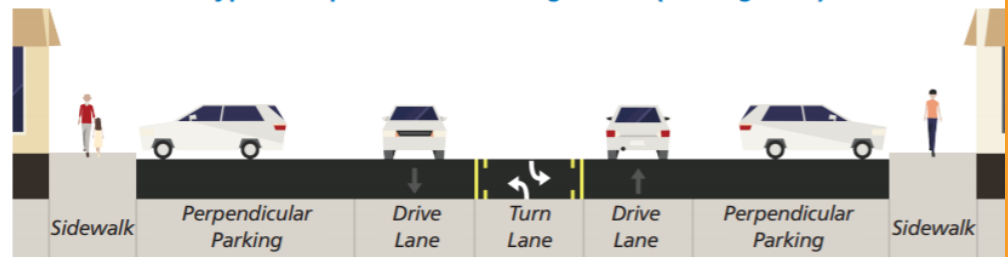

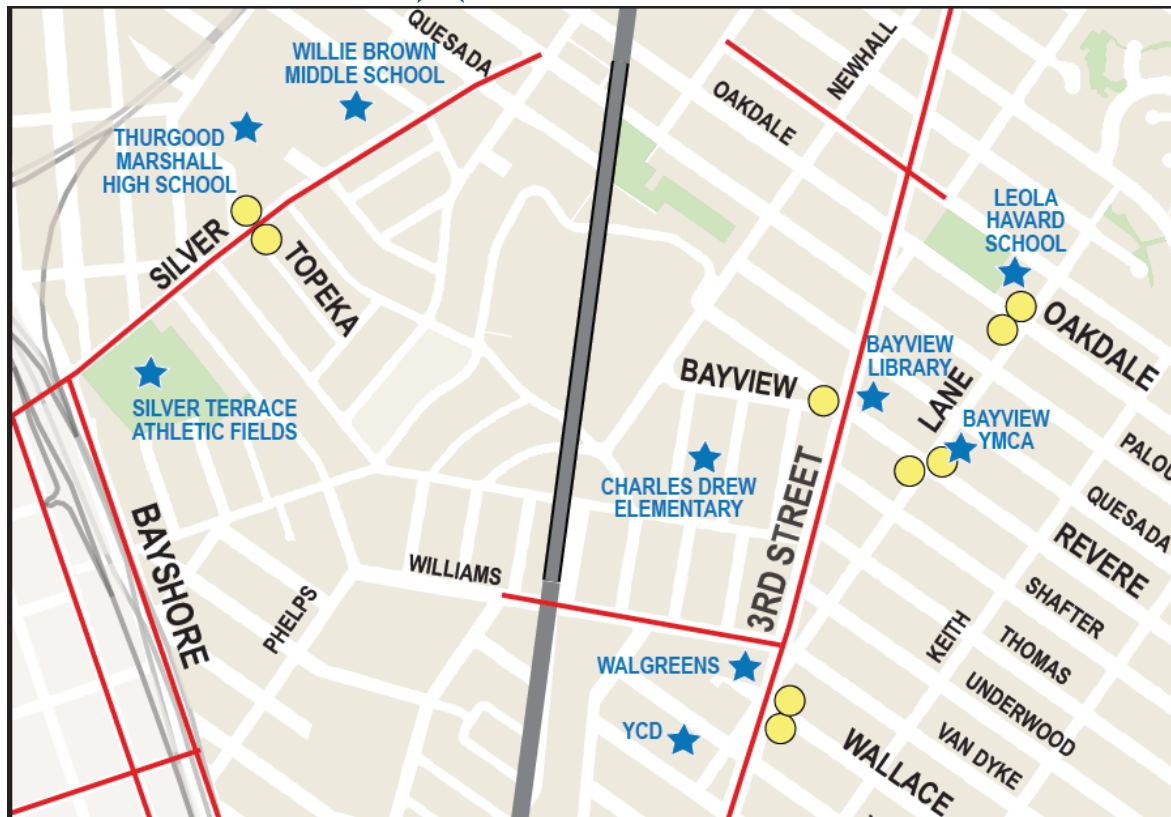

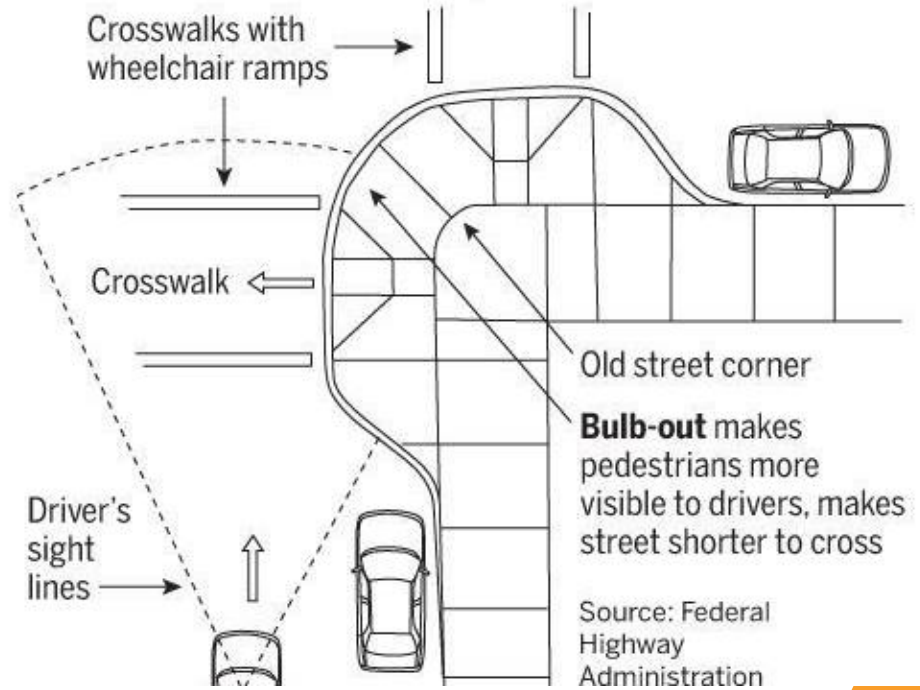
- 5 intersections selected from the Bayview CBTP
- Focus on schools & community centers
- 9 bulb-outs proposed
- 11 reported collisions in the last 5 years

BAYVIEW BULB-OUTS

269 bulb-outs installed in SF between 2017 and 2020, with over 100 installed in 2020 alone.



Bulb-outs improve pedestrian visibility, increase drivers yielding to pedestrians, and reduce driver speeds when making turns.

ATP Grant Application

Active Transportation Program

- ✓ Caltrans grant program, funds projects that promote **walking & biking** trips
- ✓ Bayview is **extremely competitive** for ATP grant funding
- ✓ SFMTA assembling grant application in the **\$7-10M** range for **January 2022** Call for Projects

Initial Ideas:

Oakdale corridor:

Pedestrian lighting, crosswalk improvements, and bike lane upgrade

Mendell to Gilman:

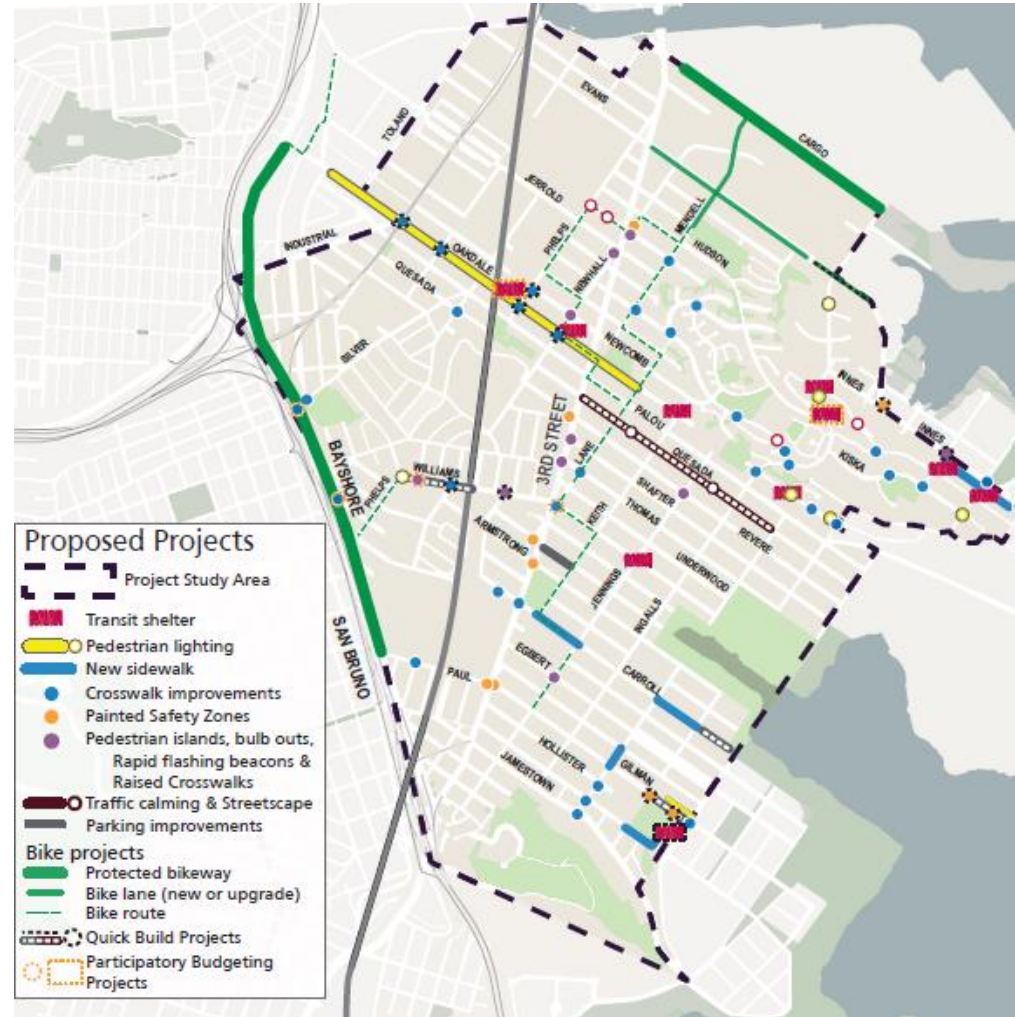
Traffic calming, intersection narrowing, and neighborhood bike route parallel to 3rd Street

Carroll corridor:

Close sidewalk gaps & improve crosswalks

Applications can include funding for local partner organizations
