In order to perform the collection process, you need to do the following.

HOW TO - FormFox collection using SFMTA's Quest account number.

- 1. Login to FormFox using your unique Username and Password.
- 2. At the first screen, select "Lab Based Drug Test (Account Number)." It is located under the section that says, "What do you want to do?"
- 3. Next, you will select the lab for SFMTA, select "Quest Labs".
- 4. After the lab selection has been made, FormFox may ask to re-enter your password. If so, enter your password and click "Submit".
- 5. On this next screen, enter the 8-digit Quest account number for SFMTA which is **10650262**. Once you enter the account number, you will click "Search".
- 6. FormFox will have you re-enter the 8-digit Quest account number for SFMTA which is **10650262**.
- 7. Once you enter it the second time, you will be able to click "Lookup Account".
- 8. You will enter the donor's information. For SFMTA, use the driver license as the donor ID number.
- 9. To enter the driver license, you will click the drop-down arrow next to SSN (social security number). A pop-up menu will appear, and you will select "DL (driver license)".
- 10. Once you have entered the driver's license number, name, and date of birth you will click "Search".
- 11. The system will do a quick search to see if there are any tests set up under this name and ID number. Once the search has been completed, you will click "Create New Test".
- 12. On the next screen the system should auto fill the DL #, DOB, date and time of arrival, and name.
- 13. You are responsible for inputting the driver's daytime and evening telephone. You can do this by clicking inside the box for phone number and enter it. If it is the same number, you can copy and paste the number you entered into the other phone number box.
- 14. On the same screen, you will also enter how the donor's ID was verified. The options are photo ID, Employer representative, and other. The driver should have their license so you can select "Photo ID".
- 15. Next, you will select the reason for the test. You do this by clicking the grey box next to reason for test and you can select the reason for test.
- 16. You need to reference the form that the driver brought in from SFMTA. The last section on this screen is the panel detail and it should default to SFMTA panel "65105N". Once all this information has been entered you will click "Next".
- 17. You may process the test as usual from this point on in FormFox.

FAQ's

1. Why is drug testing necessary?

California Government Code Section 53075.5, enacted as law in 1996, requires local entities that regulate taxicabs to institute a drug and alcohol testing policy for taxi cab drivers with the procedures that comply with applicable regulations in Part 40 and Part 382 of Title 49 from the Code of Federal Regulations. Compliance with this policy and participation in the testing program is a requirement of each Taxi Driver and therefore is a condition of the Driver permit.

2. How much does it cost?

The testing cost for new drivers and annual renewals will be paid for by the SFMTA.

3. What drugs will I be tested for?

The Taxi program requires testing for:

- Amphetamines
- Cocaine
- Ext. Opiates
- Marijuana
- MDA-Analogues
- Opiates
- Oxycodones
- Phencyclidine (PCP)

4. How often do I have to be tested?

Taxi drivers must submit a drug test:

- when they apply for New Taxi Driver permits,
- when they renew their permits annually
- if they get in an accident
- in cases where there is a "reasonable suspicion," if a supervisor/manager observes signs or symptoms of substance abuse
- in cases of returning to duty after rehabilitation from a positive test, if the company policy permits it

5. Do I have to be screened for alcohol?

Drivers are required to take alcohol breath test in the following instances:

- Post –accident
- Reasonable suspicion
- Return-to-duty
- Follow-up testing

6. What methods of testing are used?

All drug testing is based on urinalysis while alcohol testing will be based on a breath analysis



7. What is considered a positive blood alcohol level?

According to the USDOT the cut off limits would be 0.04 or greater to have a positive alcohol level

8. Where will I be tested?

See the attached list of locations for the Drug & Alcohol Testing Collection Sites.

9. Where can I obtain a Drug Chain of Custody form (CoC)?

New Applicants can obtain the Drug Chain of Custody (CoC) form at the SFMTA Taxi Customer Services Window (1 South Van Ness, 7th floor). Returning drivers can pick up the form from the SFMTA office or testing facility.

10. What happens if I test Positive?

Drivers who test positive during the permit renewal will be immediately suspended and required to complete the following:

- evaluation by Substance Abuse Professional (SAP)
- successful completion of a prescribed treatment program
- test Negative during a Return-to-Duty test

Any new Taxi Driver Permit applicant that tests positive for any of the above mentioned drugs (#3) will be automatically denied an A-card permit.

11. What happens if I refuse to test?

Consequences for refusing a test are the same as if you tested Positive for drugs or alcohol.

12. How long will it take before SFMTA will receive the results?

SFMTA will receive all negative drug test results take from 48 to 72 hours. SFMTA will receive all non-negative drug tests results take from 4 to 7 days. A breath alcohol test will give an immediate test result.

13. How will I know my results?

All negative, positive and non-negative results will be reported to the SFMTA by a MRO (Medical Review Officer). If the test is positive or a non-negative then the MRO will contact the driver who will then be asked to explain the result.

14. What does a non-negative test mean?

If your drug test does not come back negative, you will be contacted by telephone by staff from the Medical Review Officer. The MRO will review your test result and ask you questions related to why the test was not negative. You will be asked to provide information and copies of your prescriptions by email, including your Medical Marijuana card if marijuana is the issue. You must promptly comply with the MRO's request. The MRO will ultimately decide the outcome of the drug test and report it to SFMTA.

15. If my test shows a positive result will I be refunded the \$120.50 for my A-Card renewal payment?

No refunds will be granted for those who test positive for a drug, no matter the circumstance.
