15 Bayview Hunters Point Express



Bayview/Hunters Point

Located in the southeastern corner of the city, Bayview–Hunters Point possesses an industrial and naval legacy still seen today. Dogpatch

Formerly a shipbuilding hub dating back to the 1800s and indigenous land for centuries before that, this dockside area retains an industrial vibe with large warehouses, many of which have been updated into residential lofts, art galleries, and indie shops. Dogpatch is a vibrant, up-and-coming area nestled between Potrero Hill and the bay and offers a mix of trendy restaurants, brunch cafes, brewpubs and wine bars. Here you can visit...

SoMa/Mission Bay

SoMa, or South of Market, is a vast, formerly industrial district. Today SOMA Pilipinas is officially recognized as SF's Filipino Cultural Heritage District and is being revitalized as a community hub following intentional redevelopment and displacement.
