Community oversight of grant implementation, meets every 3 months



HOW IT WORKS Potential Shuttle Service Area SF General Hospital Reserve a ride through the app or a tri-lingual call center Spanish, English, Chinese).
Rides can be to anywhere within the service area. Walk to a "virtual bus stop". -+111.1.111 2. This could be your front door, the corner of your street, or one block away. Get picked up by a small shuttle vehicle. Pay a Muni fare with your Clipper Card or Monthly Transit Pass. Shuttle picks-up and drops-**4.** off other passengers along the way to your destination.


