
Project need

- Slow bus speeds (5 MPH average) on Hyde Street between McAllister & Market
- Buses run every 4 minutes here, serving 12,800+ daily riders and connecting SF neighborhoods and regional transit:
 - Muni: 19 Polk,27 Bryant, 21 Hayes
 - GGT: 101, 130, 150
- 19 Polk & 27 Bryant are key Equity Strategy Muni routes




Proposed transit lane on Hyde Street

Community engagement

- Extensive outreach starting in fall 2022 in coordination with the Hyde Street Quick Build project
- Direct outreach to local institutions on the two blocks and key neighborhood groups, such as:
 - Asian Art Museum
 - Heart of the City Farmers Market
 - Orpheum Theatre
 - San Francisco Public Library
 - Tenderloin Community Benefit District
 - UC Law San Francisco
- In general, community is supportive of a transit lane, with some modifications to address parking and loading needs





What you're voting on today

- Establishing bus, taxi and right-turn only lane on Hyde Street between McAllister and Market streets
- Removing four yellow zone loading spaces to widen lane to allow for a transit lane





Next steps

- October 3, 2023: SFMTA Board consideration (today)
- Fall 2023: If approved, quick-build implementation of transit lane in advance of the mid-November Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) CEO Summit
- Mid-2024: Implementation of permanent project with red colorization
- Related project: Hyde Street Quick-Build improvements between Geary Boulevard and McAllister Street to be considered at a future MTAB
