Bayview Community Shuttle Program: Service Planning Survey Result Summary

October 17, 2023

Number of Responses:

We received a total of **629** survey responses. 492 of those were complete and 137 partial responses. There were **1060** responses to "I would take a shuttle to...", **813** of which we were able to map.

Top Destinations:

The top destinations included:

- 1. Chinatown
- 2. San Bruno Ave commercial corridor
- 3. Downtown
- 4. SF General Hospital
- 5. BART

Doctor's offices, grocery stores, parks, and schools are also very frequently mentioned as destinations.

76 responses specifically ask for a transit (BART/Muni/Caltrain) connection, and many more destinations are directly accessible from major Muni routes such as the T.

Time of Day Summary:

We received 922 responses about what time of day residents would like to use the shuttle. **89%** of respondents would use the shuttle between the morning commute peak (6:30-9:30 AM), midday period (9:30AM – 3:30PM), and evening commute peak (3:30-6:30PM).

Of 871 responses concerning days of service, 57% would take a shuttle during the week and 43% would use the shuttle on the weekend.

Demographic Information:

Population data is estimated from the ACS 2022 5-year estimates for ZIP Code 94124.

- 1. The age distribution of our respondents is close to representative: youth are underrepresented and seniors somewhat overrepresented.
- 2. Race/Ethnicity is fairly representative, the one exception being Hispanic/Latino underrepresentation.



- 3. Respondents are more heavily female than the general population (63% of survey respondents).
- 4. Of respondents who provided their home ZIP Codes, 71% live in 94124 and 9% live in 94134.
