


Lincoln Way Quick-Build Project

Construction for the Lincoln Way Quick-Build Project is now underway! This nearly 3 mile stretch of road alongside Golden Gate Park from Arguello Boulevard to the Great Highway will be upgraded with pedestrian safety improvements. These improvements include new crosswalks, painted safety zones, left turn safety treatments, intersection daylighting, signal lens upgrades, and signal retiming upgrades (such as pedestrian head start timing, more pedestrian crossing time, and all red phases). On top of these pedestrian improvements, the SFMTA will be implementing transit improvements along Lincoln Way as part of the 29 Sunset Improvement Project, as well as new traffic signals at Kezar Drive, 10th Avenue, and 41st Avenue and signal upgrades at Great Highway.

Given the length of the corridor and inclement weather, implementation will carry on throughout spring 2024, and will coordinate with SFPW repaying along the 26th Avenue to 36th Avenue portion.

The Mid-Valencia Pilot Project was substantially installed last summer, and preliminary findings are in. Results of a three-month evaluation will be presented by the project team to the SFMTA Board of Directors in February.

The pilot, which consists of a center-running protected bikeway, an extensive curb management plan, and various pedestrian safety improvements, was approved for a twelve-month period between August 2023 through July 2024. In November, at the three-month milestone of the pilot project, the project team collected an extensive amount of data on the corridor and have been analyzing this data to determine the safety and effectiveness of the center-running bikeway. The results will be used to inform the future of bikeways along Valencia Street.

The 3rd Street Quick-Build Project wrapped up a fourweek virtual open house event this month to showcase proposed designs for a new two-way protected bikeway connection on 3rd Street between Townsend Street and the Bay Trail. The open house period was also a chance for members of the public to engage with the project team directly and provide feedback about the proposal to establish this new travel option to Oracle Park.

Following the open house, project team members will review all feedback received to further refine design proposals and prepare materials for SFMTA Board of Directors consideration. If all goes well, this new bike connection may be installed just in time for the new baseball season!
