## Under Construction



### Lincoln Way Quick-Build Project

The Lincoln Way Quick-Build Project, a nearly 3 mile stretch of road alongside Golden Gate Park from Arguello Boulevard to the Great Highway, is making great headway thanks to some recent dry weather. This pedestrian safety project is installing new crosswalks, painted safety zones, left turn safety treatments, and daylighting. SFMTA Paint Shop finished up painting new crosswalks, refreshing bus stops, and other striping at the end of this month. Work remaining to be finished includes signal timing and upgrades and some signage. The project team has coordinated with other city departments including San Francisco Public Works and San Francisco Recreation & Parks.

## Recently Completed



### 3rd Street Quick-Build Project

The 3rd Street Quick-Build Project finished construction at the end of this month. This quick-build project was installed just in time for the new Major League Baseball season, from inception to implementation within 6 months. The main component of the project is a two-way protected bike lane on the east side of Third Street from the Lefty O'Doul Bridge to Townsend Street, providing connections to Oracle Park and the Caltrain at 4th Street and King Street. On Friday, March 29, the SFMTA along with Supervisor Dorsey's Office and San Francisco Giants held a ribbon-cutting ceremony to celebrate the hard work and dedication of our all our staff, but especially the dedication of SFMTA Field Operations to delivering timely safety improvements on our streets. One very special aquatic guest was also in attendance!
