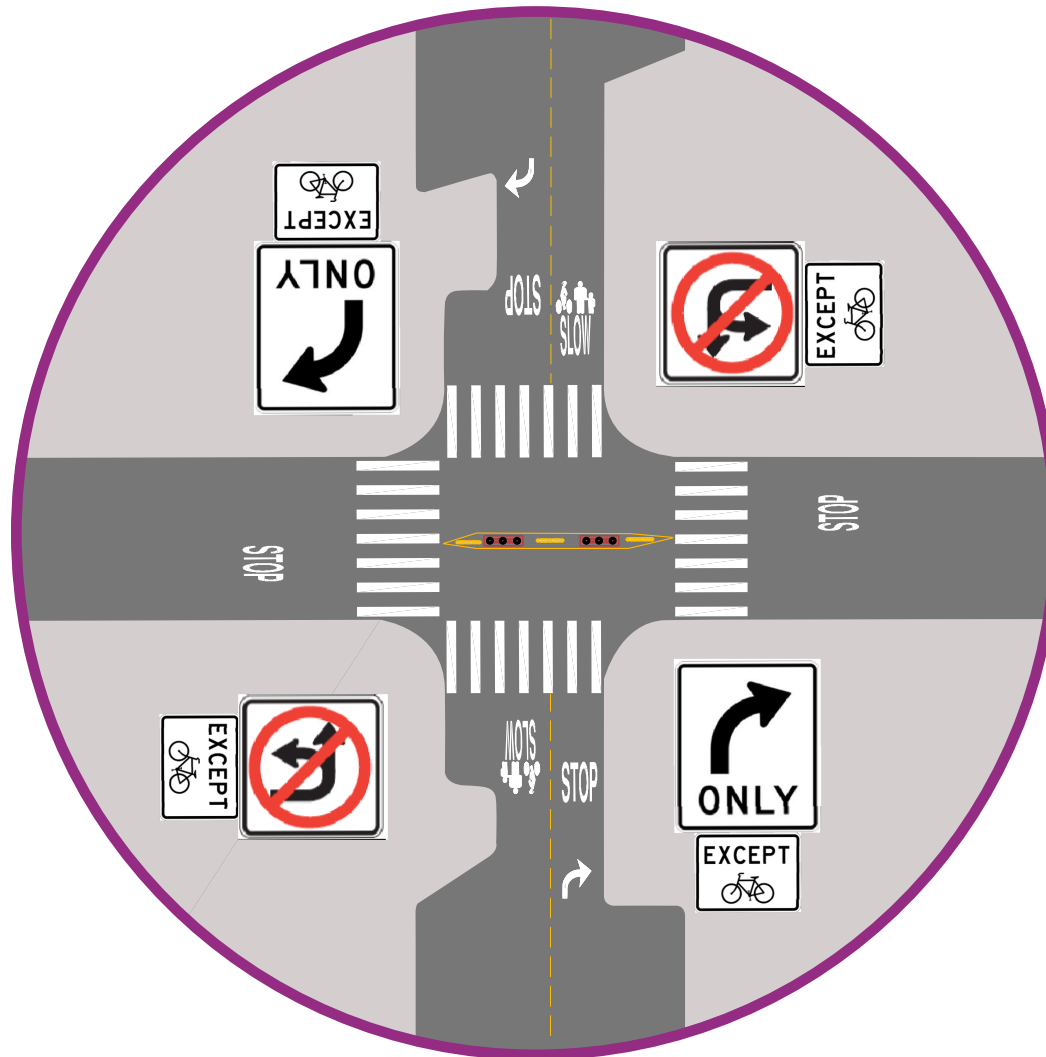

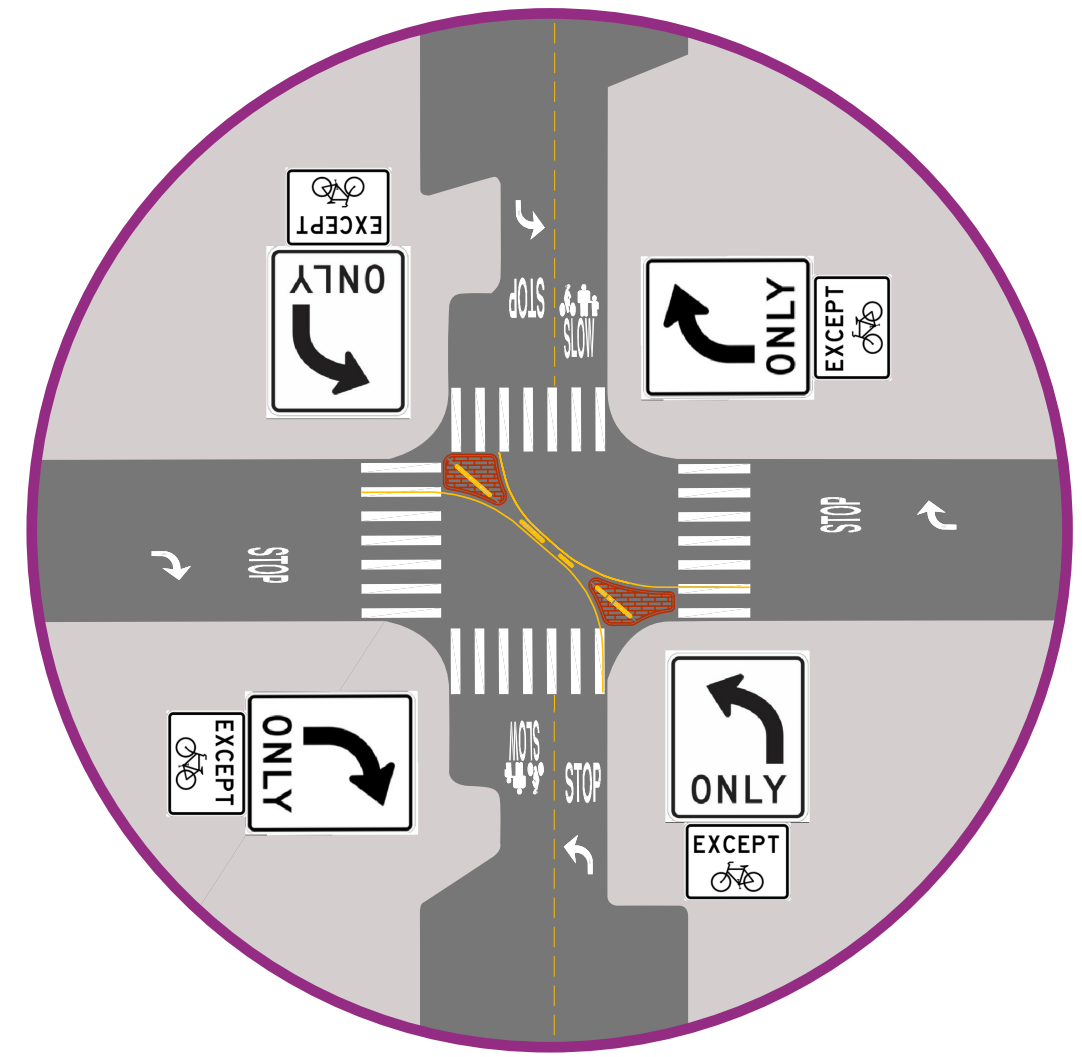
Noe Street currently has an average daily traffic volume of approximately 1,700 vehicles. To help meet the Slow Streets Program's SFMTA Board-mandated traffic volume target of 1,000 vehicles per day, the Slow Streets team is reviewing three alternatives for a traffic diverter at Noe Street and 15th Street. By placing a diverter at 15th Street, the street would remain accessible to local vehicle traffic while preventing folks from using it as a through street.

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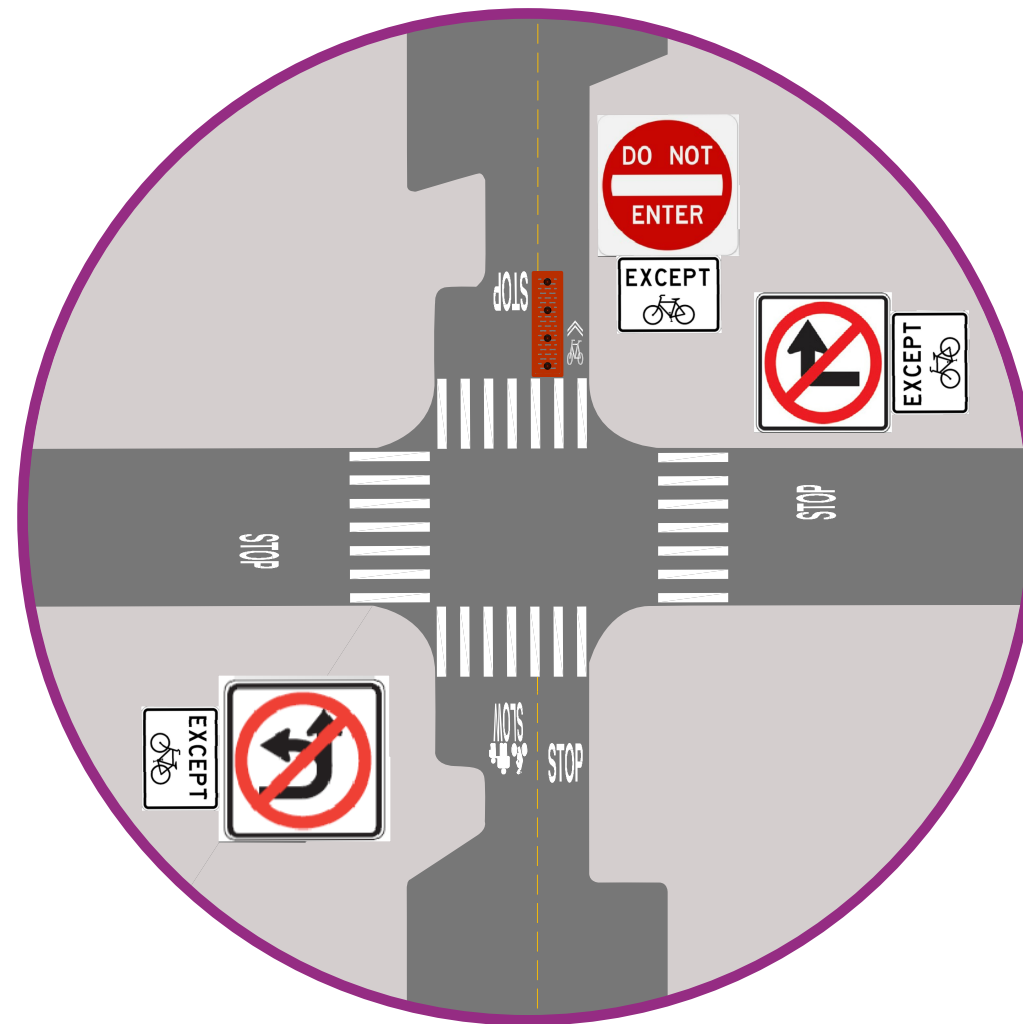
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## Option 3: Northbound-only Diverter
