 BACKGROUND INFORMATION / COMMENTS Existing condition is 2 to 5 feet shoulder on this segment of Geneva, with sharrows in the curb lane. Converts existing Class 3 bike facility to a Class 2. Connects to existing Class 2 facilities at both ends of the project limits. No impact to on-street parking supply. No reduction in the number of traffic lanes. Proposed design matches SFMTA design proposal in 2017 for award and retention of ATP grant funds. Class 4 bike facility infeasible given the number and frequency of residential driveways (every 20-feet) along this ½ mile project length. Adjacent to Crocker Amazon Playground (major recreation area with 5 soccer fields) and McLaren Park -Lane widths meet Muni and bike lane standards. Design reviewed and approved by Livable Streets and Transit Engineering.
