## SAN FRANCISCO MUNICIPAL TRANSPORTATION AGENCY Order # 5131 FOR PUBLIC HEARING

The Sustainable Streets Division of the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency will hold a public hearing on Friday, August 2, 2013, at 10:00 AM, in Room 416 (Hearing Room 4), City Hall, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, San Francisco, CA 94102, to consider the following proposals:

## 1(a). ESTABLISH – SPEED HUMPS

Oak Park Drive between Warren Drive and Christopher Drive (2 speed humps)\*

1(b). <u>ESTABLISH – SPEED CUSHIONS</u> Warren Drive between Christopher Drive and Oak Park Drive (2 speed cushions)\*

## 2. <u>ESTABLISH – STOP SIGN</u>

Hugo Street, eastbound, at Arguello Boulevard, stopping the stem of this T-intersection

#### 3. <u>ESTABLISH – PARKING METERS, NO TIME LIMIT, 9 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY</u> <u>THROUGH SATURDAY, NOON TO 6 PM, SUNDAY</u>

Division Street, both sides, between San Bruno Avenue and Vermont Street Alameda Street, both sides, between San Bruno Avenue and Vermont Street

## 4. <u>ESTABLISH – RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA X, 2-HOUR PARKING,</u> <u>8 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY</u>

Pennsylvania Avenue, west side, Mariposa Street to 253 feet southerly

## 5(a). <u>RESCIND – YELLOW METERED LOADING ZONE</u> Union Street, south side, from 100 feet to 122 feet west of Van Ness Avenue\*

5(b). <u>RESCIND – METERED MOTORCYCLE PARKING</u> Union Street, south side, from 122 feet to 131 feet west of Van Ness Avenue\*

## 5(c). <u>ESTABLISH – YELLOW METERED LOADING ZONE, 9 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY</u> <u>THROUGH FRIDAY</u>

Union Street, south side, from 108 feet to 131 feet west of Van Ness Avenue (23-foot zone)\*

5(d). ESTABLISH – METERED MOTORCYCLE PARKING 9 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY, NOON TO 6 PM, SUNDAYS

Union Street, south side, from 100 feet to 108 feet west of Van Ness Avenue (8-foot zone for two spaces)\*

## 5(e). <u>ESTABLISH – PART TIME BUS ZONE EXTENSION, 5 AM TO 9 AM, MONDAY</u> <u>THROUGH FRIDAY</u>

Union Street, south side, from 122 feet to 131 feet west of Van Ness Avenue (9-foot extension)



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## 6. <u>ESTABLISH – CROSSWALK</u> Kezar Drive at Martin Luther King Junior Drive (east side crossing)

#### 7. <u>ESTABLISH – CROSSWALK</u> Fell Street at Franklin Street (east side crossing)

# 8. <u>ESTABLISH – PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, 7:30 AM TO 9 AM, 2:30 PM TO 3:30 PM, SCHOOLDAYS</u> Gaven Street, north side, from Boylston Street to 251 feet westerly\*

## 9. ESTABLISH – BLUE ZONE

Shotwell Street, east side, from 5 feet north of 24<sup>th</sup> Street to 27 feet northerly

The following items were environmentally cleared by the San Francisco Planning Department on July 18, 2013, Case number 2009.1021E.

# 10(a). ESTABLISH – CLASS I BIKE LANE (NORTHBOUND SEPARATED BIKEWAY)

Polk Street from Market to Grove Streets (existing vehicular traffic flows southbound)

## 10(b). ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING ANYTIME

Polk Street, west side, from Hayes to Market Streets (this rescinds parking meter spaces #9, #11, #13, #15, and one blue zone) Polk Street, eastside from Hayes to Grove Streets (this rescinds parking meter spaces #104, #106, #108, #110, #112, #114, #116, #118, #120, #122 and #124)

## 10(c). RESCIND – TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING ANYTIME

Polk Street, west side, from Lech Walesa to Hayes Street

## 10(d). ESTABLISH – NO LEFT TURN EXCEPT MUNI AND TAXIS

Polk Street southbound approach Market Street (eastbound Market Street private vehicle traffic is already required to turn right at 10<sup>th</sup> Street/Polk Street and Market Street)

The following items have not yet been environmentally cleared:

## 11(a). ESTABLISH – SIDEWALK WIDENING

Castro Street, both sides, from 17<sup>th</sup> Street to 19<sup>th</sup> Street (width of widening varies from approximately 3 feet to 9 feet; sidewalks generally widened to provide 40-foot roadway width on Castro Street between 17<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> streets except in both directions approaching 18<sup>th</sup> Street, where a 50-foot roadway width will be provided to accommodate left-turn pockets)



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## 11(b). ESTABLISH – SIDEWALK WIDENING (BULBS)

Market Street, south side, from 17<sup>th</sup> Street to 72 feet easterly (6-foot wide bulb, no parking impacts)

Castro Street, east side, from 108 feet to 148 feet northerly of 19<sup>th</sup> Street (midblock 6-foot wide bulb)

18<sup>th</sup> Street, north side, from Castro Street to 30 feet easterly (6-foot wide corner bulb) 18<sup>th</sup> Street, south side, from Castro Street to 35 feet westerly (6-foot wide corner bulb)

## 11(c). ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING ANYTIME

Castro Street, east side, from 108 feet to 148 feet northerly of 19<sup>th</sup> Street (midblock 6-foot wide bulb)

18<sup>th</sup> Street, north side, from Castro Street to 30 feet easterly (6-foot wide corner bulb) 18<sup>th</sup> Street, south side, from Castro Street to 35 feet westerly (6-foot wide corner bulb)

## 11(d). RESCIND - TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING 4 PM TO 6 PM

Castro Street, west side, from 16<sup>th</sup> Street to Market Street

#### 11(e). ESTABLISH – RIGHT LANE MUST TURN RIGHT EXCEPT MUNI Southbound Castro Street at Market Street

#### Southbound Castro Street at Market Stree

## 11(f). ESTABLISH – BUS ZONES

Castro Street, east side, from 17<sup>th</sup> Street to 100 feet southerly (100-foot zone, replaces 68-foot bus bulb)

Castro Street, west side, from 17<sup>th</sup> Street to 115 feet southerly (115-foot zone, replaces 96-foot bus bulb)

Castro Street, east side, from 18<sup>th</sup> Street to 100 feet southerly (100-foot zone, extending existing 66-foot zone)

Castro Street, west side, from 18<sup>th</sup> Street to 115 feet southerly (100-foot zone, extending existing 76-foot zone)

#### 11(g). ESTABLISH – RED ZONES

Castro Street, east side, from 18<sup>th</sup> Street to 45 feet northerly Castro Street, west side, from 18<sup>th</sup> Street to 29 feet northerly



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#### 11(h). <u>ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING 3 PM TO 7 PM, MONDAY THROUGH</u> FRIDAY

Castro Street, west side, from 18<sup>th</sup> Street to 107 feet northerly

# 11(i). ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY LANE MUST TURN RIGHT EXCEPT MUNI

Southbound Castro Street at 18th Street

## 11(j). ESTABLISH – GENERAL METERED PARKING

Castro Street, west side, from 107 feet to 147 feet north of 18<sup>th</sup> Street (2 spaces)\* Castro Street, east side, from 148 feet to 192 feet south of 18<sup>th</sup> Street (2 spaces)\* Castro Street, east side, from 252 feet to 292 feet south of 18<sup>th</sup> Street (2 spaces)\* Castro Street, west side, from 203 feet to 223 feet north of 19<sup>th</sup> Street (1 space)\* Castro Street, west side, from 19<sup>th</sup> Street to 37 feet north (2 spaces)\*

## 11(I). ESTABLISH – PART-TIME PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, DURING PERFORMANCES

Castro Street, east side, from 118 feet to 160 feet south of 17<sup>th</sup> Street (42-foot zone, 2 spaces)\*



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#### 11(m).<u>ESTABLISH – YELLOW METERED SIX-WHEEL COMMERCIAL VEHICLE LOADING</u> (8 AM TO 3 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY)

Castro Street, west side, from 115 feet to 203 feet south of 17<sup>th</sup> Street (88-foot zone, 4 spaces)\*

## 11(n). <u>ESTABLISH – YELLOW METERED LOADING (8 AM TO 3 PM, MONDAY THROUGH</u> <u>FRIDAY, 30-MINUTE LIMIT)</u>

Castro Street, east side, from 160 feet to 204 feet south of 17<sup>th</sup> Street (44-foot zone, 2 spaces)\* Castro Street, east side, from 158 feet to 224 feet north of 18<sup>th</sup> Street (66-foot zone, 3 spaces)\* Castro Street, west side, from 167 feet to 239 feet north of 18<sup>th</sup> Street (72-foot zone, 3 spaces)\* Castro Street, east side, from 100 feet to 148 feet south of 18<sup>th</sup> Street (48-foot zone, 2 spaces)\* Castro Street, east side, from 162 feet to 210 feet north of 19<sup>th</sup> Street (48-foot zone, 2 spaces)\* Castro Street, west side, from 115 feet to 159 feet south of 18<sup>th</sup> Street (44-foot zone, 2 spaces)\* Castro Street, west side, from 30 feet to 74 feet east of Castro Street (44-foot zone, 2 spaces)\* 18<sup>th</sup> Street, south side, from 103 feet to 124 feet east of Castro Street (changes parking meter #4015, yellow metered loading 7 AM TO 6 PM, Monday through Saturday)\* 18<sup>th</sup> Street, north side, from 78 feet to 122 feet east of Collingwood Street (changes parking meters #4116 and #4118, yellow metered loading 7 AM TO 1 PM, Monday through Friday)\*

## 11(o). <u>ESTABLISH – YELLOW METERED LOADING (8 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH</u> <u>FRIDAY, 30-MINUTE LIMIT)</u>

Castro Street, west side, from 99 feet to 143 feet north of 19<sup>th</sup> Street (44-foot zone, 2 spaces)\*

## 11(p). ESTABLISH – YELLOW METERED LOADING (3 PM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, 30-MINUTE LIMIT)

Castro Street, west side, from 55 feet to 99 feet north of 19<sup>th</sup> Street (44-foot zone, 2 spaces)\*

## 11(q). ESTABLISH – METERED MOTORCYCLE PARKING

Castro Street, east side, from 204 feet to 254 feet south of 17<sup>th</sup> Street (13 motorcycle spaces)\* 18<sup>th</sup> Street, north side, from 80 feet to 105 feet west of Castro Street (6 motorcycle spaces, shortens existing 105-foot bus zone by 25 feet)\*

# 11(r). ESTABLISH – TAXI ZONE (6 PM TO 6 AM EVERYDAY)

Castro Street, east side, from 100 feet to 148 feet south of 18<sup>th</sup> Street (48-foot zone)\*

The following item has not yet been environmentally cleared:

## 12. ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY, NO STOPPING ANYTIME

Bayshore Boulevard, west side, from Paul Avenue to Bacon Street
