



Transit Stops

The project proposes bus boarding islands for the inbound 43 Masonic stops at Cloud Circle (South), Cloud Circle (North) at Lee Ave, and Gennessee Street. The project would also consolidate (remove) the existing bus stops at campus crossing, which has substantially lower ridership than the adjacent stops.



Example of a bus boarding island with protected bikeway in the SOMA neighborhood. Boarding islands allow for level, in-lane dropoffs and pickups and shorter crossing distances.

Campus Crossing


The Diego Rivera Theater (DRT) project plans to close the existing driveway at the main campus

crossing for a more pedestrian-oriented connection. When this project moves forward in a few years, it may allow the north-bound left turn lane to be repurposed. SFMTA staff will monitor opportunities revisit on-street parking and loading configurations along Frida Kahlo Way.




E-Bikes & Scooters Must Use Bikeway

Example of a parking-protected bikeway on The Embarcadero with painted pedestrian access aisle


Two-way Protected Bikeway


on the east side of Frida Kahlo Way and the south side of Judson Avenue. The proposed bikeway increases safety for people using bikes, scooters, power wheelchairs, and other active transportation modes; connects to bikeways on Ocean Avenue, Lee Avenue/North Access Road, and Gennessee Street; and is designed to support emergency vehicle access. On Judson Ave, the bikeway will be protected by a combination of 'floating' parking and concrete islands at intersections.



Summary of Curb Management Changes

This table summarizes the proposed changes to vehicle and motorcycle parking and bikeshare on Frida Kahlo Way between Ocean Avenue and Judson Avenue and on Judson Avenue (south side only) between Frida Kahlo Way and Foerster Avenue.
