WALK

- INCREASED PEDESTRIAN VISIBILITY
- SHORTER CROSSING DISTANCES
- LOWER VEHICLE SPEEDS



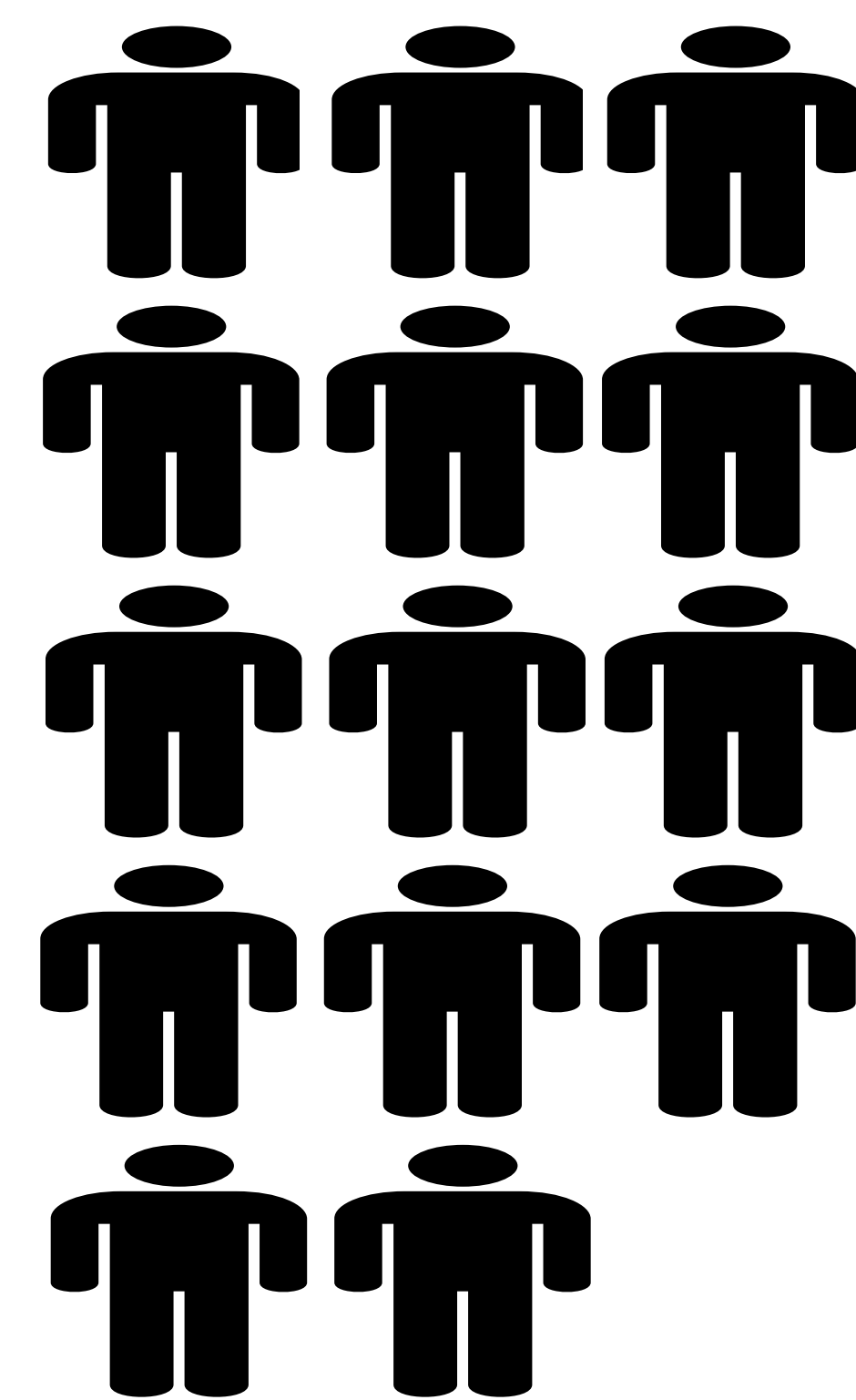
WAIT

- SAFER BOARDING & ALIGHTING
- HIGHER ON-TIME PERFORMANCE

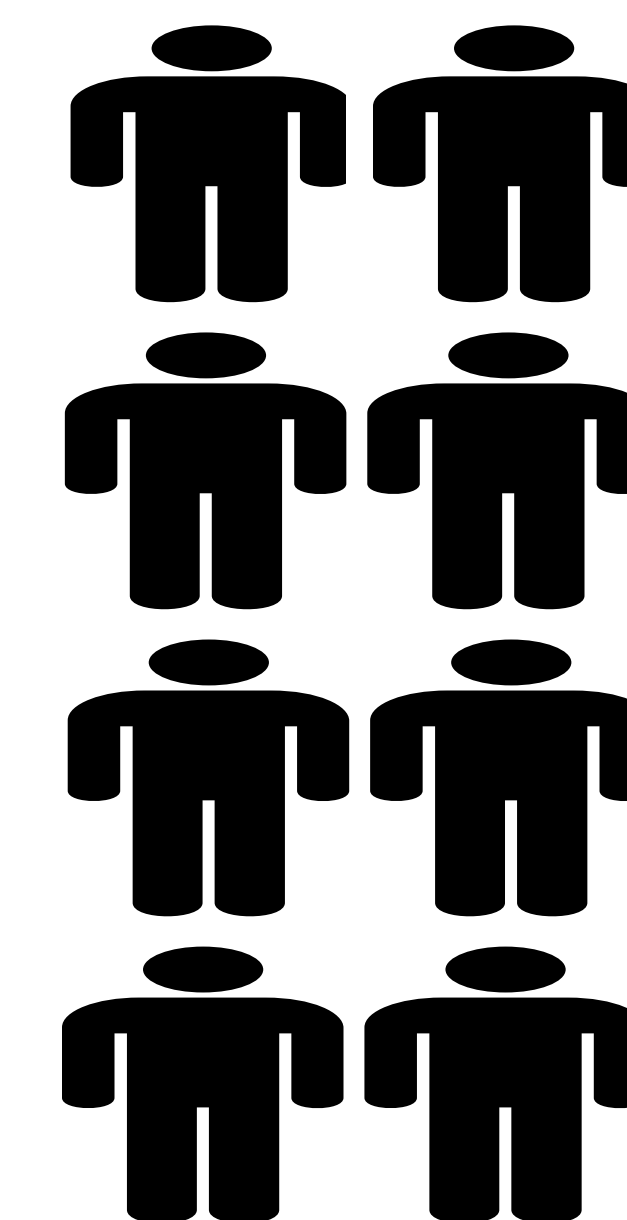


RIDE

- FASTER BOARDING TIMES
- FEWER STOPS
- LESS DELAY
Savings of 10 minutes or 30% roundtrip on entire corridor



A total of 28,000 people board the L Taraval each day between 46th Avenue and Embarcadero



Of the total daily boardings, 9,000 occur at stops along the Taraval corridor




PARK

- LOSS OF PARKING SPOTS
To achieve safer and quicker boarding/disembarking of the trains, on-street parking will need to be removed in select areas.

SHELTERS

BOARDING ISLANDS PROVIDE SPACE FOR SHELTERS




WAIT

- INCREASED STOP SPACING
Average stop spacing would increase from 700 feet to 1000 feet
