Veterans Day Holiday Muni Service

Tuesday, Nov. 11 (Veterans Day Holiday), Muni will operate on a weekday non-school schedule.

Veterans Day Holiday Parking Enforcement

Tuesday, Nov. 11 (Veterans Day Holiday), parking meters (all meters including color capped), white zones, nightly street sweeping (street cleaning) and safety violations (no stopping, no parking, red and blue zones) will be enforced.

Other SFMTA parking programs will not be enforced:

- Residential Parking Permits (RPP) Zones
- General Parking Time Limits
- Weekday Daytime Street Sweeping (Street Cleaning)
- Commuter Shuttle Towaway Zones
- Unmetered Yellow and Green Zones

Veterans Day Holiday Parking Enforcement *continued*

Vehicles creating a hazard and/or an unsafe condition (i.e. double parking, blocking a bike lane, blocking driveways, blocking crosswalks, fire hydrants, etc.) are subject to receiving citations and can possibly be towed.

Note: Parking meters in the city are enforced Monday through Saturday **with exception of the following areas where parking meters are enforced seven days per week throughout the year except Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Year's Day:**

- Parking meters in the Fisherman's Wharf area
- On and near The Embarcadero roadway
- In the Special Event Area around Oracle Park and Chase Center
- Four metered off-street parking facilities listed below:
 - 8th Avenue at Clement Street
 - 9th Avenue at Clement Street
 - Geary Boulevard at 21st Avenue
 - 18th Avenue at Geary Boulevard

Some parking garages (notably Pierce Street Garage between Lombard and Chestnut streets) are paid parking, 24/7 including all holidays.

Downtown First Thursdays

Thursday, Nov. 6: The Downtown First Thursdays (DFT) event will take place on 2nd Street from 5 to 10 p.m. This is a free monthly street party that takes place every first Thursday of the month. For event details, visit www.dftsf.com.

The following street closures will be required from noon until midnight, Thursday:

- 2nd Street between Market and Folsom streets
- Clementina Street between 2nd and 1st streets
- Jessie Street between New Montgomery and 2nd streets
- Minna Street between New Montgomery and 1st streets
- Natoma Street between New Montgomery and 1st streets
- Stevenson Street between New Montgomery and 1st streets
- Tehama Street between Hawthorne and 1st streets

These intersections will remain open at all times: 1) 2nd and Mission streets; 2) 2nd and Howard streets.

There will be no impact on Muni service.

Event at Chase Center

Friday, Nov. 7 to Sunday, Nov. 9: There will be a couple events to take place at the Chase Center:

- **Friday, Nov. 7:** Performance by [Shane Gillis](#) will take place. Show will begin at 8 p.m. Doors will open at 7 p.m.
- **Sunday, Nov. 9:** The Warriors will host a home game against the [Indiana Pacers](#). Game will begin at 5:30 p.m. Doors will open at 4 p.m.

Muni will provide supplement 78X Arena Express service:

- *Pre-event express shuttle service* from 16th Street BART Station to Chase Center will start two and a half hours before each game/event and will end one hour after game/event starts.
- *Post-event express shuttle service* from Chase Center on 16th Street to 16th Street BART Station will run until the clears.

Special Event Parking Rates

During basketball games and other area major events with more than 10,000 expected attendees at the arena, parking meters close to the arena will charge a special event rate of \$12 per hour. These rates help reduce congestion and keep parking spots available in the neighborhoods near the arena, discouraging circling for free or cheap parking. Start times for special event rates vary based on the start time of the event. More information on special event parking regulations can be found on www.sfmta.com/special-event-parking.

Street Closures

To accommodate events that will take place at the arena, the following street closures will be enforced two hours before and one hour after each event:

- 1) 16th Street between 3rd Street and Terry Francois Boulevard
- 2) Warriors Way between 3rd Street and Terry Francois Boulevard
- 3) Northbound 3rd Street between 16th Street and Warriors Way will also be closed approximately 30 minutes before and 45 minutes after the event.

Only local access will be allowed on Northbound Illinois Street between Mariposa and 16th streets.

No Parking Zone

To facilitate loading and pick up for Muni customers and patrons, NO PARKING will be in effect at these locations during events:

- 16th Street between 3rd Street and Terry Francois Boulevard
- Warriors Way between 3rd Street and Terry Francois Boulevard
- Between the 500 and 700 blocks of Terry Francois Boulevard (TFB)

Taxi Stands

There is one taxi stand located on southbound Terry Francois Boulevard.

Ramp Taxis should use the loading zone on eastbound Warriors Way at Bridgeview Way.

Other pickup/drop-off locations near Chase Center

- 4th Street, which connects to Chase Center via the Gene Friend Way pedestrian path on the UCSF campus.
- Owens Street, which also connects to Chase Center via the Gene Friend Way pedestrian path on the UCSF campus.

Veterans Day Parade

Sunday, Nov. 9: The annual Veterans Day Parade will take place. Formation will begin at 9 a.m. with parade to commence at 11 a.m. from North Point Street and The Embarcadero to Aquatic Park, via The Embarcadero and Jefferson Street.

The Embarcadero north of North Point and Jefferson streets to Aquatic Park will be closed to traffic during the parade, approximately between 10 a.m. and 1 p.m.

The following Muni lines and routes will be affected: **F Market & Wharves; 8 Bayshore; 28 19th Avenue; and 39 Coit.**

CONSTRUCTION WORK AND OTHER UPDATES

UPDATE: Caltrans Work—04-0X5804 I280 and US-101

Now through Saturday, Nov. 8: To facilitate Caltrans construction work to install signage and striping, the following on and off ramp closures will be required as listed:

- **Southbound 280 Off Ramp to Geneva Street** will be closed from 11:59 p.m., Wednesday, Nov. 5 to 7 a.m., Thursday, Nov. 6
- **Southbound 280 Off Ramp to John Daly Boulevard** will be closed from 11:59 p.m., Wednesday, Nov. 5 to 4:30 a.m., Thursday, Nov. 6
- **Northbound 280 Off Ramp to San Jose Avenue** will be closed from 9 p.m., Wednesday, Nov. 5 to 6 a.m., Thursday, Nov. 6
- **Northbound 280 Off Ramp to Alemany Boulevard** will be closed from 10 p.m., Thursday, Nov. 6 to 6 a.m., Friday, Nov. 7
- **Southbound 101 Off Ramp to San Bruno Avenue** will be closed from 1 to 4 a.m., Thursday, Nov. 6
- **Southbound 101 Off Ramp to Bayshore Boulevard** will be closed from 1:30 to 5 a.m., Thursday, Nov. 6
- **Northbound 101 Off Ramp to 3rd Street** will be closed from 10 p.m., Friday, Nov. 7 to 7 a.m., Saturday, Nov. 8
- **Northbound 280 Off Ramp to Cesar Chavez Street** will be closed from 1 to 5 a.m., Friday, Nov. 7
- **Southbound 280 Off Ramp to Mariposa/18th Street** will be closed from 7 p.m., Friday, Nov. 7 to 7 a.m., Saturday, Nov. 8

Unless there is any change of work plans by Caltrans crews, this construction work will take place as listed. Signage will be placed in advance of these closures and detour routes.

UPDATE: Sewer Replacement and Street Reconstruction in the Wharf Area

Now through mid-November: As part of this work, bus stops will be relocated and some bus lines will be rerouted. The work area is Powell Street between Jefferson and North Point streets, and, on North Point Street between Mason and Powell streets. The following Muni routes will be impacted by the construction work:

- The 39 Coit: Some stops will be relocated

ONGOING

ONGOING: Caltrans Work—04-1Q802 US101 (Hospital Curve)

This construction project will be upgrading drainage along US101 between Cesar Chavez Street and the interchange of US-101/I-80. Two of three traffic lanes will be closed as listed:

- Daily closure: From 9 p.m. to 7 a.m. to the next day, Monday through Friday
- Weekend closure: From 11 p.m. to 8 a.m. the next day, Saturday and Sunday

ONGOING: Caltrans Work—04-4K1104 (19th Avenue)

The construction project will be reconstructing the parking strip on Northbound Highway 1 (19th Avenue) between Holloway Avenue and Lincoln Way. The right traffic lane will be closed for up to two blocks at a time, from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. daily, Monday to Friday.

ONGOING: SFPUC Geary Boulevard Sewer and Water Replacements

Now until 2027: Replacement work of sewer and water lines is currently taking place along Geary Boulevard between 32nd Avenue and Stanyan Street. Due to construction work at multiple locations, some of the bus stops for Muni routes 38 Geary and 38R Geary Rapid will be temporarily relocated nearby. Riders should look for orange signage at impacted bus stops.
