- Improve travel time

- Coordinate with regional transit providers
- Improve data analysis and reporting
- Focus on accessibility (vehicles, facilities, potential sites, elevators/escalators, etc.)
- Promote shifting modes to active transportation
- Improve Communications
- Facilitate the movement of goods as well as people

Feedback from the SFMTA Board – February 7

- Promote interagency and regional partnerships

 - Communications and education programs discussing purpose of treatments
