

DOWNTOWN SAN FRANCISCO COMMUTER BART STRIKE OPTIONS FACT SHEET

Muni services in the vicinity of available parking facilities and casual carpool departure points are indicated on the map on the back of this fact sheet. Muni bus routes are indicated with numbers while Muni rail lines are indicated with letters. Adult full fare is \$2. Youth and Senior/Disabled fare is 75 cents. Exact change or Clipper Cards are required on Muni vehicles; Muni Metro tickets can be purchased at the Metro vending machines in the subway stations for use at subway fare gates.

In the event of a BART strike, commuters to San Francisco are advised to avoid peak driving periods by working at home if possible (or traveling earlier or later than usual), form a carpool or try casual carpooling, or take an alternative transit service.

San Francisco-East Bay Casual Carpooling Departure Points: 3 to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday

- Carpooling Departure Point C1 for East Bay locations along the Richmond BART Line is located on Beale Street between Howard and Folsom streets.
- Carpooling Departure Point C2 for East Bay locations along the Fremont and Dublin/Pleasanton BART lines is located on the west side of Spear Street between Howard and Folsom streets.
- Carpooling Departure Point C3 for East Bay locations along the Pittsburg/Baypoint BART Line is located on the east side of Spear Street between Howard and Folsom streets.

Parking: Off-Street Parking Facilities

South of Market Street:

- AT&T Park, Lot A, 3rd Street south of the ballpark (Game-day rates apply on Giants game days)
- Moscone Center, 3rd Street between Folsom and Howard streets
- 5th and Mission Street Garage, Mission Street between 5th and 4th streets

North of Market Street:

- Golden Gateway Garage, Clay Street between Battery and Davis streets
- St. Mary's Garage, Kearny Street at California Street
- Ellis/O'Farrell Garage, Ellis Street between Stockton and Powell streets
- Sutter/Stockton Garage, Bush Street between Stockton and Grant streets
- Union Square Garage, Geary Street between Stockton and Powell streets
- Civic Center Garage, McAllister Street between Larkin and Polk streets
- Performing Arts Garage, Grove Street between Franklin and Gough streets

SFpark is a pilot project that assists with finding parking information—Visit the website at sfpark.org or download the app to find real-time information about available spaces and rates in pilot neighborhoods: Financial District, along the Embarcadero, Fisherman's Wharf, Civic Center, Marina Union Street, and the Mission District.

Ferry Terminal

Cross The Embarcadero and proceed to Market Street to make Muni transit connections.

Taxi Service

In the morning, taxi stands will be at key transfer points: the Transbay Terminal and the Caltrain Station. Evening taxi stands are at downtown hotels. A map of the hotel stands is available on sfmta.com.

Bike

Consider commuting by bicycle or walk to your destination. If you plan to use a bicycle for your commute, a map of bicycle routes is available on sfmta.com.
