

- RAISED CROSSWALK AT ALLEYS
- PUBLIC REALM IMPROVEMENTS
- LANDSCAPING IMPROVEMENTS (SUPPLEMENT/INFILL TREE PLANTINGS)
- PEDESTRIAN LIGHTING IMPROVEMENTS
- ROADWAY BASE REPAIR & RESURFACING
- UTILITY AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS
- TWO-WAY BIKEWAYS

**Roadway pedestrian lighting, street trees, and raised crosswalks at alleys are the priorities for the public realm.**


