Outreach Process (March 15 – April 16, 2021)



Received **944** visitors to the Shotwell Virtual Open House



Led **four** virtual open house events, with **72** attendees



Attended **two** community group meetings (Calle 24 - Land Use Committee and Central Mission Neighbors)



Collected **114** submissions on the design feedback form and **42** comments/photos were submitted on the traffic safety map on the Shotwell Slow Street virtual open house webpage

Key Findings from Outreach

Issues: through vehicle traffic continues to access the street and new traffic diverter design may not be effective enough

Roadway design solutions: reassess and adjust new traffic diverter design and incorporate other operational changes to better reduce through vehicle traffic

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Left-turn

- Reduce through

- Three intersections to receive turnrestriction
- treatment



- Reduce through
 vehicle traffic
- Could be applied to most
- intersections on
- Shotwell Street
- No operational impacts for local traffic



Crosswalks

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- Improve pedestrian visibility
- Four intersections to be upgraded
- No operational impacts

New Sign and Diverter Plan

Replace barricades and existing delineators with new delineator layouts

- New diverter set-ups will be more visible and better deter through-drivers from using Shotwell
- New delineator-mounted signs
- Placed further out into street



Next Steps and Current Outreach

- Mailers to all residents along Shotwell and adjacent surrounding streets with proposed design
- Posters posted along Shotwell Slow Street
- Email/text blast to promote virtual open house event and feedback period
- **Two SFMTA-led virtual meetings** today and June 5
 - We'll attend any other community/neighborhood group meetings too!
- Team to review feedback and refine the design throughout June
- Final public review:
 - Official SFMTA Engineering Public Hearing for Shotwell Slow Street: July 30th
 - Slow Streets Program wide update and next steps July 20th SFMTA Board of Directors meeting
