

Contract Modification #14

- Adjustments to light/Muni poles and foundations
- Revise irrigation systems
- Additional traction power cable
- Furnish and install CCTV poles and foundations
- Repair work to existing roadway

Total is \$717,878, to be funded through existing project budget. This does not extend the length of the project.

Construction update

Current work

- ~95% of the bulb out work is complete
- Irrigation and backfill work ongoing in the median
- All traffic signals except Lombard have been cutover to the new signal boxes
- Tree planting at the sidewalk is progressing towards Mission; median trees to follow

Geary Rapid Project

Construction work on the <u>Geary Rapid Project</u>, in coordination with San Francisco Public Utilities Commission and San Francisco Public Works, is nearly complete. Installation of red transit lane treatments is underway. All other contract work is complete, including 1.5 miles of new sewer, almost three miles of upgraded water mains, 1.5 miles of roadway repaving, three new and eight upgraded traffic signals, four new pedestrian crossings, 32 pedestrian bulb-outs, 12 transit bulb-outs and 38 upgraded curb ramps.
