FOR PUBLIC HEARING

of SAN FRANCISCO

The Sustainable Streets Division of the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency will hold a public hearing on Friday, July 5, 2013, at 10:00 AM, in Room 416 (Hearing Room 4), City Hall, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, San Francisco, CA 94102, to consider the following proposals:

1. ESTABLISH – NO PARKING ANYTIME

Redwood Street, both sides, from Franklin Street to 140 feet westerly

2. ESTABLISH – NO PARKING ANYTIME

Wawona Street, south side, between the 20th Avenue eastern and western crosswalks

3. ESTABLISH – NO PARKING ANYTIME

Whitney Young Circle, east side, from 15 feet to 78 feet north of Bell Court Whitney Young Circle, west side, from Bell Court to 30 feet northerly

4. <u>RESCIND – RED ZONE</u>

Texas Street, east side, from 22nd Street to 20 feet northerly*

5. <u>ESTABLISH – RED ZONE</u>

Parkridge Drive, east side, from Burnett Avenue to 15 feet northerly (extends existing red zone to Burnett Avenue)*

Burnett Avenue, north side, from Parkridge Drive to 25 feet easterly (establishes red zone along the curvature of the northeast corner)

6. <u>ESTABLISH – UNMETERED MOTORCYCLE PARKING</u>

20th Street, south side, between driveways for 3635 and 3641 20th Street (approximately three motorcycle stalls)*

7. ESTABLISH – 45-DEGREE ANGLE PARKING

Irving Street, south side, from 63 feet to 134 feet west of 12th Avenue (extends the current angle parking arrangement to encompass the yellow zone and green zone in front of 1117 and 1127 Irving Street)

8. ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY NO PARKING ANYTIME

3rd Street at Bayshore Boulevard east frontage road (40-foot zone along curved north side portion of curb)

Bayshore Boulevard east frontage road, west side, from T-Third retaining wall at the end of 3rd Street to 100 feet northerly

Keith Street, west side, from Le Conte Avenue, to the north property line of 1885 Bayshore Boulevard (365-foot zone)

Keith Street and Le Conte Avenue, southeast corner (50-foot zone along curved portion of curb)



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9. ESTABLISH – RED ZONE

Fulton Street, south side, from Clayton Street to 20 feet westerly*

10. ESTABLISH – RED ZONE

9th Street, west side, from 2 feet to 20 feet south of Mission Street (removes general metered parking space #102)*

11. ESTABLISH – RED ZONE

Brannan Street, south side, from Gilbert Street to 19 feet westerly (removes existing passenger loading zone)*

12. ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING ANYTIME

Athens Street, east side, from Italy Avenue to 18 feet southerly Athens Street, west side, from Italy Avenue to 16 feet northerly

13(a). ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING ANYTIME

Sutter Street, south side, from Stockton Street to 20 feet easterly

13(b). <u>RESCIND – YELLOW METERED SIX-WHEEL LOADING ZONE</u> <u>ESTABLISH – TAXI ZONE, AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT 4 PM – 6 PM,</u> <u>MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY</u>

Sutter Street, south side, from 137 feet to 160 feet east of Stockton Street (23-foot zone)*

14. ESTABLISH – RIGHT TURN ONLY

2nd Avenue, northbound and southbound, at California Street

15. <u>ESTABLISH – PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, 8 AM TO 9 AM AND 3 PM TO 4 PM,</u> <u>SCHOOLDAYS</u>

117 Diamond Street, east side, from the northernmost driveway to 100 feet northerly (establishes new 100-foot passenger loading zone)



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The following items were environmentally cleared by the Planning Department on May 18, 2012, for information gathering purposes for a pilot project.

- 16(a). <u>RESCIND TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING, 7 AM TO 9 AM AND 4 PM TO 6 PM</u> Howard Street, north side, from Beale Street to 200 feet westerly*
- 16(b). ESTABLISH YELLOW METER LOADING ZONE, 7 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

Howard Street, north side, from 10 feet to 46 feet west of Beale Street*

16(c). <u>ESTABLISH – NO PARKING EXCEPT BICYCLES (FOR BIKE SHARE STATION)</u> Howard Street, north side, from 46 feet to 106 feet west of Beale Street (60-foot, 4-inch bike share station in general meter spaces # 306, 310, 312)*

17(a). <u>ESTABLISH – YELLOW METER LOADING ZONE, 7 AM TO 11 AM, MONDAY</u> <u>THROUGH SATURDAY</u> <u>ESTABLISH – PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, 11 AM TO 11 PM, MONDAY THROUGH</u> <u>SATURDAY</u>

Townsend Street, north side, from 197 feet to 229 feet west of 4th Street (32-foot zone)*

17(b). ESTABLISH – NO PARKING EXCEPT BICYCLES (FOR BIKE SHARE STATION)

Townsend Street, north side, from 229 feet to 297 feet west of 4th Street (66-foot, 4-inch bike share station in general meter spaces # 2, 3, 4, 5)*

18(a). RESCIND – SIDEWALK BICYCLE SHARING STATION

Market Street, north side, from 10 feet to 50 feet 6 inches east of Bush Street (Mechanics Plaza) (50-foot, 6-inch,19-dock bike share station RELOCATED)*

18(b). ESTABLISH – SIDEWALK BICYCLE SHARING STATION

Market Street, north side, from 58 feet to 109 feet east of Bush Street face of curb (50-foot, 6-inch bike share station)*

The following items were environmentally cleared by the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District in a Notice of Determination dated May 24, 2013, State Clearinghose number 95063004.

19(a). ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING ANYTIME

4th Street, east side, from Perry Street to 20 feet northerly Perry Street, north side, between 3rd and 4th Streets

19(b). <u>RESCIND – ONE-WAY STREET</u>

Perry Street, westbound, between 3rd and 4th Streets



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19(c). ESTABLISH - ONE-WAY STREET Perry Street, eastbound, between 3rd and 4th Streets

19(d). <u>ESTABLISH – TRAFFIC SIGNAL</u> 3rd Street and Perry Street

Items denoted with an asterisk (*) can be given final approval at the public hearing. Otherwise, the SFMTA Board will make the final approval at a later date based on the outcome at the public hearing.

The purpose of traffic engineering hearings for the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) Sustainable Streets Division is for residents to express their concerns regarding the posted parking and traffic changes affecting their streets. At the hearing, the public hearing officer, after reviewing the items and listening to residents, will make a decision as to whether the items are approved or not. Any interested parties are encouraged to attend.
