#### Supplemental Muni Service

- Muni will operate supplemental **78X Arena Express** service.
- **Pre-event express shuttle service** from 16<sup>th</sup> Street BART Station to Chase Center will start two and a half hours before each game/event and will end one hour after game/event starts.
- **Post-event express shuttle service** from Chase Center on 16<sup>th</sup> Street to 16<sup>th</sup> Street BART Station will run until the area clears.

## Special Event Parking Rates

During basketball games and other major events with more than 10,000 expected attendees at the arena, **parking meters close to the arena will charge a special event rate of \$10 per hour**. These rates help reduce congestion and keep parking spots available in the neighborhoods near the arena, discouraging circling for free or cheap parking. Start times for special event rates vary based on the start time of the event. More information on special event parking regulations can be found on <u>www.sfmta.com/special-event-parking</u>.

## Street Closures

To accommodate events that will take place at the arena, the following street closures will be enforced two hours before and one hour after each event:

- 16<sup>th</sup> Street between 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and Terry Francois Boulevard
- Warriors Way between 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and Terry Francois Boulevard
- Northbound 3<sup>rd</sup> Street between 16<sup>th</sup> Street and Warriors Way will also be closed approximately 30 minutes before and 45 minutes after an event.
- Only local access will be allowed on Northbound Illinois Street between Mariposa and 16<sup>th</sup> streets.

## No Parking Zone

To facilitate loading and pick up for Muni customers and patrons, NO PARKING will be in effect at these locations during events:

- 16<sup>th</sup> Street between 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and Terry Francois Boulevard
- Warriors Way between 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and Terry Francois Boulevard
- Between the 500 and 700 blocks of Terry Francois Boulevard (TFB)

## Taxi Stands

There is one taxi stand located on southbound Terry Francois Boulevard. Ramp Taxis should use the loading zone on eastbound Warriors Way at Bridgeview Way.

# The following street closures will be required for the event from 11 p.m., Friday, Feb. 23 to 11 p.m., Sunday, Feb. 25:

- Grant Avenue between California Street and Broadway
- Pacific Avenue between Columbus Avenue and Stockton Street
- Jackson Street between Stockton and Kearny streets
- Washington Street between Stockton and Kearny streets
- Intersections at Grant Avenue: Jackson Street, Washington Street and Pacific Street
- All alleys in the area bounded by California Street, Stockton Street, Broadway and Kearny Street

There will be heavy traffic in the area. Motorists are advised to allow extra travel time.

The **12 Folsom/Pacific** Muni route will be affected.



## Chinese New Year Parade

**Saturday, Feb. 24**: The Chinese New Year Parade will start from 2<sup>nd</sup> and Market streets at 5:30 p.m. The parade will travel west on Market Street, west on Geary Street, north on Powell Street, east on Post Street and north on Kearny Street to Columbus Avenue. ## The SFMTA will provide extra LRV Metro service to support the expected crowds.

Staging of the floats will begin at 10 a.m. in the parking lane of Main Street between Market and Harrison streets. The following street closures will be required:

- From 2 p.m.:
  - o 2<sup>nd</sup> Street between Market and Mission streets
- From 3 p.m.:
  - Main Street between Harrison and Market streets
  - Market Street between Main and 3<sup>rd</sup> streets
  - Main Street between Harrison and Market streets
  - Geary Street between Market and Powell streets
  - Powell Street between Geary and Post streets
  - Post Street between Powell and Kearny streets
  - Kearny Street between Post Street and Columbus Avenue
- From 5 p.m. to approximately 9:30 p.m.:
  - Columbus Avenue south of Pacific Avenue
  - Jackson Street between Kearny and Sansome streets
  - $_{\odot}$   $\,$  Washington Street between Kearny and Sansome streets
  - o Clay Street between Kearny and Sansome streets

Beginning at 3 p.m., Mission Street between 5<sup>th</sup> Street and The Embarcadero will be designated as transit-only street until Market Street re-opens to transit.

Traffic along Market Street will be diverted during the event:

- Westbound to Howard Street
- Eastbound to Folsom Street

The following Muni lines and routes will be affected: California Cable Car; Powell-Mason Cable Car; Powell-Hyde Cable Car; F Market & Wharves; 1 California; 2 Sutter; 5 Fulton; 6 Haight/Parnassus; 7 Haight/Noriega; 8 Bayshore; 9 San Bruno; 12 Folsom/Pacific; 14 Mission; 14R Mission Rapid; 15 Bayview Hunter's Point Express; 30 Stockton; 38 Geary; 38R Geary Rapid and 45 Union/Stockton.

# **CONSTRUCTION WORK AND OTHER UPDATES**

## UPDATE: L Taraval Improvement Project—Segment B

The L Taraval Improvement Project is a multi-agency collaboration to improve safety, accessibility, and transit reliability, and to rehabilitate aging rails, utility lines and roadway pavement along the L Taraval line between Sunset Boulevard and 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue and on Ulloa Street near West Portal.

Work to install new rails, boarding islands, boarding ramps and curb ramps continues. Track installation is approximately 68% complete. The work zone for the track installation on Taraval Street between 19<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> avenues is anticipated to be restricted to one lane of traffic in each direction until Friday, Feb. 23, after which some parking will be released. The last track area activation is anticipated to start on Monday, Feb. 12, between 33<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and Sunset Boulevard.

# Construction work is taking place at these locations:

- Taraval Street between 15<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> avenues: construct bulb-out, reconstruct sidewalk, curb ramp, boarding platforms
- Taraval Street between 19<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> avenues: track area, remove and install tracks
- Taraval Street between 23<sup>rd</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> avenues: construct sidewalks, boarding islands and ADA compliant platforms
- Taraval Street between 31<sup>st</sup> and 34<sup>th</sup> avenues: street base work, (intermittent street closures with one block at a time are expected), sidewalk reconstructions
- Taraval Street between 34<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Sunset Boulevard: water, sewer line work and track work
- Ulloa Street between Forest Side and 15<sup>th</sup> avenues: track work, sidewalk reconstruction

Nighttime work is scheduled from Sunday through Friday, from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. on Taraval Street between 19<sup>th</sup> and 35<sup>th</sup> avenues to upgrade the Overhead Contact System (OCS) that powers the trains. Work on any given block will vary and is expected to take a few hours to a few days per location. OCS work is expected to be completed in June 2024.

The L Bus now runs between West Portal and the SF Zoo. Customers can transfer to a train at West Portal Station to travel downtown. An interactive bus reroute map with temporary bus stop relocations citywide during construction can be found on <u>Interactive Bus Reroute</u>.

During construction, the L Taraval bus stops are being relocated. The inbound bus stop at Taraval Street and 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue has been relocated across the intersection until fall 2024.

    - From 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Ulloa Street to Madrone Avenue and Ulloa Street, northwest corner
  - Outbound
    - From Ulloa Street and Lenox Way to West Portal Avenue and Ulloa Street, southeast corner
    - From 14th Avenue and Ulloa Street to Taraval Street and 14th Avenue, northeast corner
    - From 14th Avenue and Taraval Street to northeast corner
- L Taraval Bus / L Special / L Owl (Effective from Monday, Feb. 12 to Friday, March 22, 2024)
  - Inbound
    - From Taraval and 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to Ulloa Street and 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, southwest corner
    - From Taraval Street and 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue to northeast corner (28 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue stop)
    - From Taraval Street and 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Santiago Street and 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue, southwest corner
    - From Taraval and 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue to northwest corner
  - Outbound
    - From Ulloa Street and Forest Side Avenue to Ulloa Street and Lenox Way, northwest corner
    - From Taraval Street and 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Taraval Street and 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue, southeast corner
    - From Taraval Street and 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue to southwest corner (28 Line Stop)
    - From Taraval Street and 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue to southeast corner

## Masks Recommended

Following the latest guidance from the <u>California Department of Public Health</u> (CDPH), San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA), masks are strongly recommended but no longer required in any SFMTA facilities, transit hubs or on vehicles including Muni buses, streetcars, light rail vehicles or cable cars or in taxis or on paratransit.

## **ONGOING: Essential Trip Card Discount Program**

The SFMTA's program, <u>Essential Trip Card</u> (ETC) Program, assists people with disabilities and older adults to make essential trips using taxis. The program provides two to three round trips at an 80% discount per month, i.e. rider pays \$6 to receive a value of \$30 or pays \$12 to receive a \$60 value. If essential needs require it, riders may receive additional value up to \$120 of taxi service per month.

To qualify for the program, customer must be either age 65 or older or an adult with disabilities. Eligible adults may apply for the ETC program by calling the Paratransit Mobility Management office at 415-351-7053.
