What is a roadway closure?

- Regular/Recurring events
 - Roadway Shared Space
 - Sponsor requested
 - Recurrence is weekly or monthly
 - Permitted through ISCOTT;
 MTA Board approval is required if scope exceeds duration or frequency.
- Non-recurring events:
 - Special Event permit through ISCOTT


Hayes Shared Street Permit

November 2024, SFMTA Board approved a slightly expanded scope to focus on creating success:

- Fridays 4-10 pm and Saturdays 10 am-10 pm
 - Earlier Saturday start time to allow more setup time
 - Demonstrate compliance with permit terms
 - Find opportunities and partnerships for activation
 - Ensure business loading and other needs are met
 - Reduce impacts to 21-Hayes (now 6-Hayes/Parnassus)
 - Improved activation and compliance to increase merchant support

Sales Tax Data

Sales on Hayes Street have recovered from the pandemic (2020).

Current Permit: Successes

- More consistent activation
- Improved intersection barricade configuration
 - Discourages double parking at intersections
- Many neighbors report enjoying the community gathering space
- Business impacts
 - Some merchants report positive impacts to business





March to October Activation

Most activation was on Saturdays.

Of 70 total permit days, 45 days reported programming, including:

- Chalk and yard games
- Live music and dance classes
- HV Art walk
- HV Carnival

- Doggie Farmers Market
- African American Shakespeare Company Performance
- Halloween Pet Parade



Current Permit: Challenges

- Muni Service
 Reroute
 - Confusing to riders, especially Sunday re-route due to weekend service plan restrictions
- Business impacts
 - Some merchants report negative impacts to business


Current Permit: Challenges

Compliance issues reported:

- Inconsistent staffing at barricades
- Delivery scooters/mopeds driving into the closure
- Parked vehicles in the closure
- Unpermitted clothing vendor
- Lack of posted permit

Response:

- Staff have communicated violations to permittee and permittee has committed to addressing them.
- Staff continue to monitor.
- Permittee continues to provide weekly photos to document compliance.



October 23, 2025 ISCOTT Hearing

Hayes Valley Neighborhood Association application:

Friday, November 28, 2025, through Saturday, November 28, 2026

- 4 pm to 10 pm, each Friday
- 10 am to 10 pm, each Saturday
- 10 am to 10 pm, each Sunday

Applicant requests restoring pandemic hours (3 days) for a greater diversity of events.





October 23, 2025 ISCOTT Hearing

Support

- Application package included 6 Letters of support from businesses
- 235 Emails
 - From residents in the area
 - From visitors who frequent HV more often with the street closures
 - Fosters community
 - More open space to shop, relax, enjoy activities
- 21 Public comments
 - Open space is a respite from surrounding hightraffic streets

Oppose

- 215 Emails
 - 7 From businesses/merchants on surrounding blocks
 - Hurts small business
 - Divides neighborhood
 - Violations of permit conditions
- 3 Public comments
 - Compliance issues
 - Need to consider wider impact on the neighborhood

Other/Neutral (2)

- Noise complaints
- Traffic concerns

Next Steps – Board Action

ISCOTT recommended permit to be considered by Board for **Friday** and **Saturday** only.
