Downtown First Thursdays

Thursday, Dec. 4: The Downtown First Thursdays (DFT) event will take place on 2nd Street from 5 to 10 p.m. This is a free monthly street party that takes place every first Thursday of the month. For event details, visit www.dftsf.com.

The following street closures will be required from noon until midnight, Thursday:

- 2nd Street between Market and Folsom streets
- Clementina Street between 2nd and 1st streets
- Jessie Street between New Montgomery and 2nd streets
- Minna Street between New Montgomery and 1st streets
- Natoma Street between New Montgomery and 1st streets
- Stevenson Street between New Montgomery and 1st streets
- Tehama Street between Hawthorne and 1st streets

These intersections will remain open at all times: 1) 2nd and Mission streets; **2)** 2nd and Howard streets.

There will be no impact on Muni service.

Cruzada Guadalupana

Saturday, Dec. 6: La Cruzada Guadalupana Pilgrimage is a yearly event that starts in South San Francisco and proceeds through San Francisco to St. Mary's Cathedral. The procession will begin at 6 a.m. and is anticipated to reach the San Francisco border with Daly City between 9 and 9:45 a.m. It will then proceed via Mission Street, 14th Street, South Van Ness, Ellis Street, and Gough Street to Geary. The procession will make one stop mid route at the Parish Church of St. John the Evangelist at Mission Street and St Mary's Avenue. Approximately 10,000 people, 25 horses, and 18 vehicles (including sound trucks, floats, Red Cross vans, Radio La Raza trucks, water and supply trucks) will be a part of this procession.

The following street closures will be required from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Saturday:

- Mission Street / Sickles Avenue and 1111 Gough Street

The following Muni routes will be impacted: **14 Mission, 14R Mission Rapid, 33 Ashbury/18th and 49 Van Ness/Mission**. Streets along the procession route may also be congested which could impact additional Muni bus service in the area.

San Francisco Police Department officers and the SFMTA's Parking Control Officers will monitor the march.

Dogpatch Holiday Market

Saturday, Dec. 6: The Dogpatch Holiday Market returns to celebrate the season in one of San Francisco's most creative neighborhoods. Event will take place from 11a.m. to 5 p.m.

A street closure of 22nd Street between 3rd and Illinois streets will be required from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m., Saturday.

The following Muni route will be impacted: 48 Quintara/24th Street.

The following Muni routes will be affected: **8 Bayshore; 8AX Bayshore A Express; 8BX Bayshore B Express; 15 Bayview Hunters Point Express; 30 Stockton; 45 Union/Stockton; 91 3rd Street/19th Avenue Owl; and T Third Street Bus.**

New: Fix It! Weekend–N Judah Bus Substitution for Maintenance Work

Saturday, Dec. 6 and Sunday, Dec. 7: The SFMTA, in partnership with PG&E, will conduct important maintenance work along the N Judah line. To ensure crews can complete this work safely and efficiently, some sections of the line may temporarily be run by Muni buses.

A partial motorization of N Judah service will support various inspection and maintenance projects along the trackway between Ocean Beach and Church/Duboce. Each day from 8 a.m. to midnight, Saturday, Dec. 6 and Sunday, Dec. 7, N Judah will operate with Muni buses between Ocean Beach and Church/Duboce. N Judah trains will operate between Church/Duboce and Caltrain. Customers can transfer between bus and train at Church/Duboce.

N Judah Bus Shuttle will only serve curbside stops for the N-Bus and N-Owl in the Sunset District. N Judah Bus Shuttle will not serve train boarding island stops.

During this service change period, the N-Owl buses will operate the normal route and schedule.

Regular, full-length train service between Ocean Beach and Caltrain will resume at 8 a.m. on Monday, Dec. 8.

UPDATE: Sewer Replacement and Street Reconstruction in the Wharf Area

Now through mid December: As part of this work, bus stops will be relocated and some bus lines will be rerouted. The work area is Powell Street between Jefferson and North Point streets, and, on North Point Street between Mason and Powell streets. The following Muni routes will be impacted by the construction work:

- The 28 19th Avenue will be affected
- The 39 Coit: Some stops will be relocated

UPDATE: Caltrans Work—04-4K1104 (19th Avenue)

Caltrans contractor is currently working on Phase 1 (Concrete Parking Strip Work). On Monday Dec. 1, the contractor crew started working on northbound 19th Avenue at Sloat Boulevard and are working their way northbound to Lincoln Way. One northbound lane will be closed from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. daily, from Monday to Friday. Caltrans contractor will maintain two lanes of traffic open during working hours and work will affect four blocks at a time. Once Northbound is completed they will do the same for southbound 19th Avenue starting at Lincoln Way and working south to Sloat Boulevard.

ONGOING: SFPUC Geary Boulevard Sewer and Water Replacements

Now until 2027: Replacement work of sewer and water lines is currently taking place along Geary Boulevard between 32nd Avenue and Stanyan Street. Due to construction work at multiple locations, some of the bus stops for Muni routes 38 Geary and 38R Geary Rapid will be temporarily relocated nearby. Riders should look for orange signage at impacted bus stops.
