	<p><b>Bayview Community Shuttle: Rider Panel</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. <b>Summary of minutes:</b> Angel of SFMTA posed questions to two top Bayview Shuttle riders, who spoke about their experiences frequently using the shuttle. Some of the top riders' highlights: appreciation and surprise when the expanded service area happened, especially noting the ease to get to Candlestick Park - which has generally been neglected by public transportation - and making an area near San Bruno Avenue more accessible. They noted the price felt fair, and that MUNI discounts apply to the Bayview Shuttle if a rider has them otherwise. They also noted building connections with the Shuttle drivers; that they're very kind and patient with riders and remember riders (such as one of the top riders' mother).</li> <li>b. Community members asked the top riders questions about their experiences; where the top riders have used the app to travel, how close they live to popular dropoff and pickup points, whether the top riders have experienced any service lags on the Bayview Shuttle app.</li> </ul>

	<p><b>November 30 2027</b> marks the proposed grant expiration date. This timeline is subject to a grant amendment with CARB approval.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Bayview Shuttle is celebrating its first birthday on Nov 13th from 12 - 2 pm at the Southeast Community Center.</li> <li>○ SFMTA shared that the Bayview Shuttle was awarded two APA Awards in 2025: Opportunity and Empowerment Award of Excellence and Transportation Planning Award of Excellence.</li> <li>○ Other updates: Shuttle is fully staffed, with another hiring period likely coming in early 2026.</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Public Comment</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Summary of Minutes:</b> Community Congress members and new attendees brought up several concerns and questions.</li> <li>● <b>Concern 1:</b> members are sometimes rejected from ride requests during service hours while in the Bayview Shuttle service area. Sometimes a “You’re out of the pickup zone” message appears on the app while people are clearly within the zone. Occasionally crossing the street helps the app locate the individual requesting a ride.</li> <li>● <b>Concern 2:</b> Dispatch is not very available to answer questions in a timely manner.</li> <li>● <b>Question 1:</b> Can Clipper cards / passes be sold at more accessible locations in the Bayview? Selling them at more corner stores would be helpful, especially since the Walgreens shut down on 3rd.</li> <li>● <b>Pending Change (SFMTA):</b> Shuttle payment processors should be updated to receive debit / credit cards.</li> </ul>
