Project Background

The Bosworth-Monterey Connections Quick-Build Project aims to connect crosstown bike routes and Slow Streets to improve safety on San Francisco’s active-transportation network, while addressing multimodal safety at key intersections. Improvements will complement past study efforts and will address community requests. Changes under consideration include:

- Pedestrian beacon at 280 on ramp
- New crosswalk on Bosworth and Lyell
- New raised crosswalk on Cayuga and Lyell
- Fill in gaps in bikeway network



What We’re Hearing

“I mainly commute by bike (with a child in tow) and that turn can feel particularly treacherous with cars flying by in both directions [Bosworth St/ Arlington St]. Can someone please evaluate adding signage/signaling to protect this turn a bit more? Both for cyclists and motorists?”

“As you’re driving north on Circular Ave. approaching Monterey Blvd and the Highway 280 North onramp, please designate the right-most lane as a Right Turn Only to enter on Highway 280 North. There is ample room for 2 lanes, but a high percentage of drivers will wait in the middle of the space.”

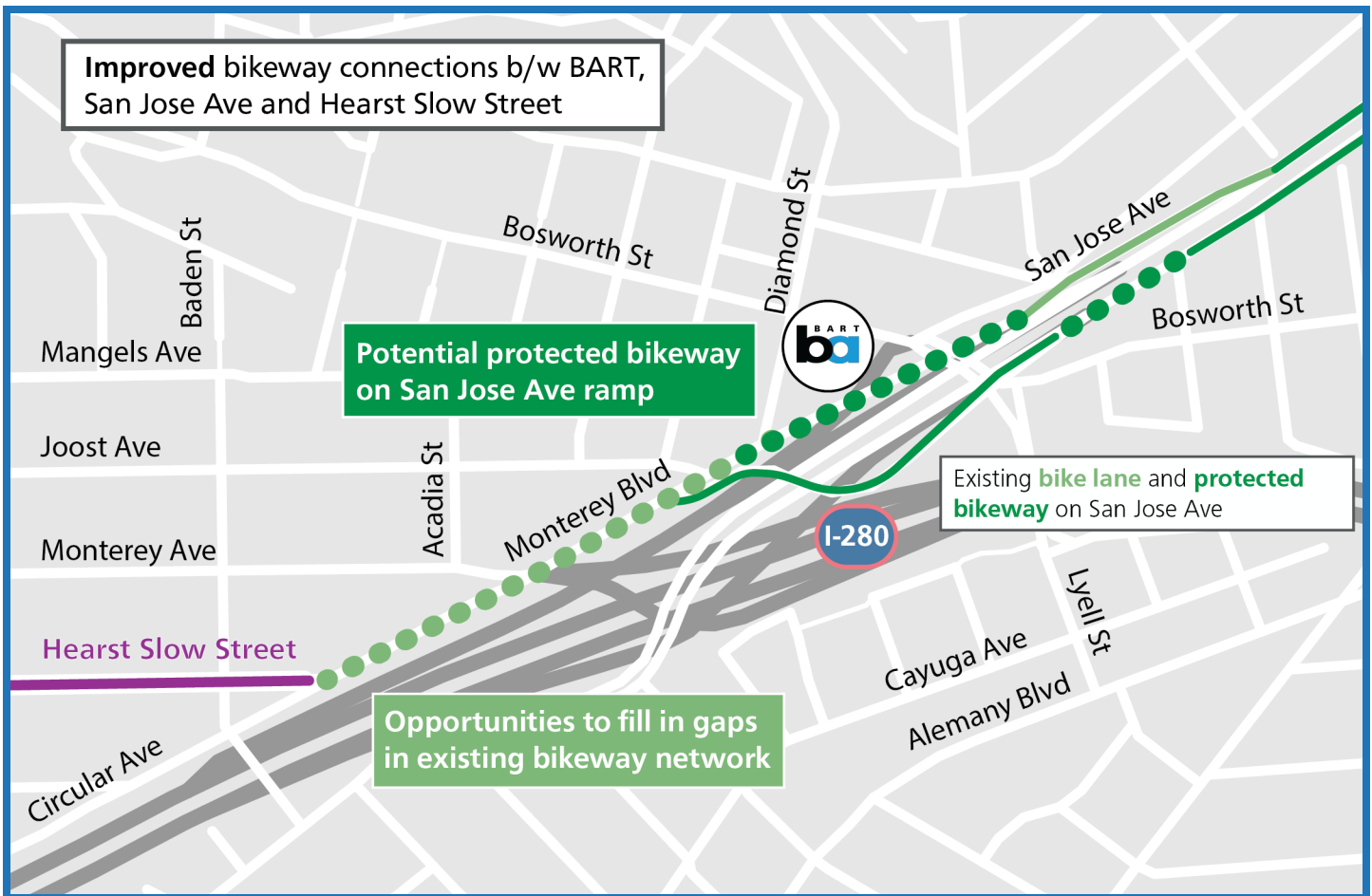
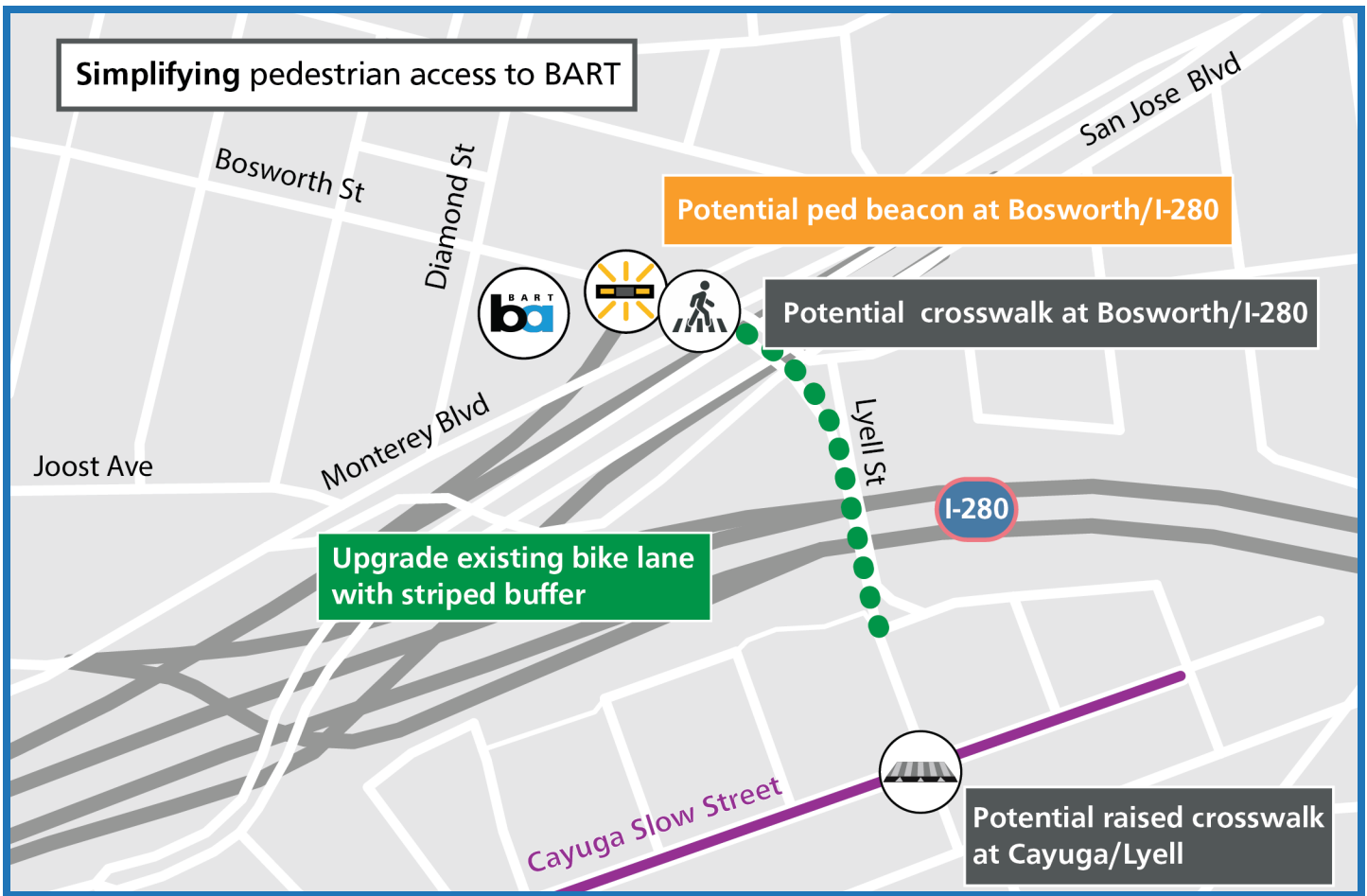
“Would be nice to add in street furniture to slow down the turns off the freeway [Circular Ave/ Monterey Blvd]. The way it is now allows car to turn quickly with no regard for other vulnerable users like cyclists. There needs to be more safety features at this large intersection.”

Safe Streets Directive and the Quick-Build Program

Safe Streets Directive is a citywide policy with the goal of eliminating all serious and fatal traffic collisions. The **Quick-Build Program** is an SFMTA effort to quickly implement pedestrian and bicycle safety improvements. The SFMTA implements quick-build safety projects to decrease the number of people fatally and severely injured on San Francisco streets, resulting in progress towards the SFMTA’s Safe Streets Directive commitment.
