WHEREAS, In 2009, Intueor Consulting, Inc., under a subcontract with AECOM, the Central Subway Project Management/Construction Management contractor, oversaw development of the SFMTA Capital Programs and Controls System (CPCS) for the SFMTA Capital Programs & Construction (CP&C) Division; and,

WHEREAS, The CPCS will be an agency-wide program controls software system capable of tracking capital project budgeting, financing, scheduling, staff charges, contractor payments, and construction contract activities; and,

WHEREAS, The SFMTA wants to expand the CPCS to the Sustainable Streets Division (SSD) to manage its over 300 active projects in various phases of planning, design and construction; and,

WHEREAS, The SFMTA obtained approval of a sole source waiver from the Human Rights Commission to enter into a contract with Intueor Consulting, Inc. to expand the CPCS; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors authorizes the Director of Transportation to execute Contract No. SFMTA-2014-05 with Intueor Consulting Inc. for the expansion of the Capital Programs and Control System to include the Sustainable Streets Division, for an amount not to exceed \$1,400,000, and a contract term of one year and nine months.
