6. Public Comment:

Edward Mason stated that during the past months it has been extremely cold, and it creates an uncomfortable ride on the buses. There should be a policy established for a consistent comfortable temperature to entice riders to return to riding Muni.

7. Presentation, discussion, and possible action regarding Temporary Emergency Transit Lanes. (Steve Boland, Transportation Planner III. Explanatory documents include a slide presentation.)

Steve Boland, Transportation Planner III, presented the item.

Edward Mason discussed the importance of Environmental Impact Reports.

Hayden Miller stated that he supports the lanes and looks forward to them being made permanent.

8. Presentation, discussion, and possible action regarding Bus Propulsion and 30' bus acquisition. (Gary Chang, Senior Program Manager. Explanatory documents include two slide presentations.)

Steven Lin, Junior Engineer and Becky Chan, Associate Engineer presented the item.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Edward Mason asked what prevented the disclosure of the photo of the bus to be delivered in December 2020. He also asked if there will be adequate electrical power to charge the buses at night and has fuel cell technology been eliminated from consideration by the SFMTA.

9. Committee member requests for information. (For discussion only)

Frank Zepeda asked if there is a policy for turning the heat on in the buses or if it is at the Operator's discretion. The windows are often open on the bus to increase airflow because of COVID and it can get extremely cold on the buses. He asked if there are plans to create a policy regarding heating the buses.

Dorris requested an update on the Van Ness Improvement Project.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Edward Mason suggested that the EMSC schedule a presentation on the State mandate on hybrid buses.
